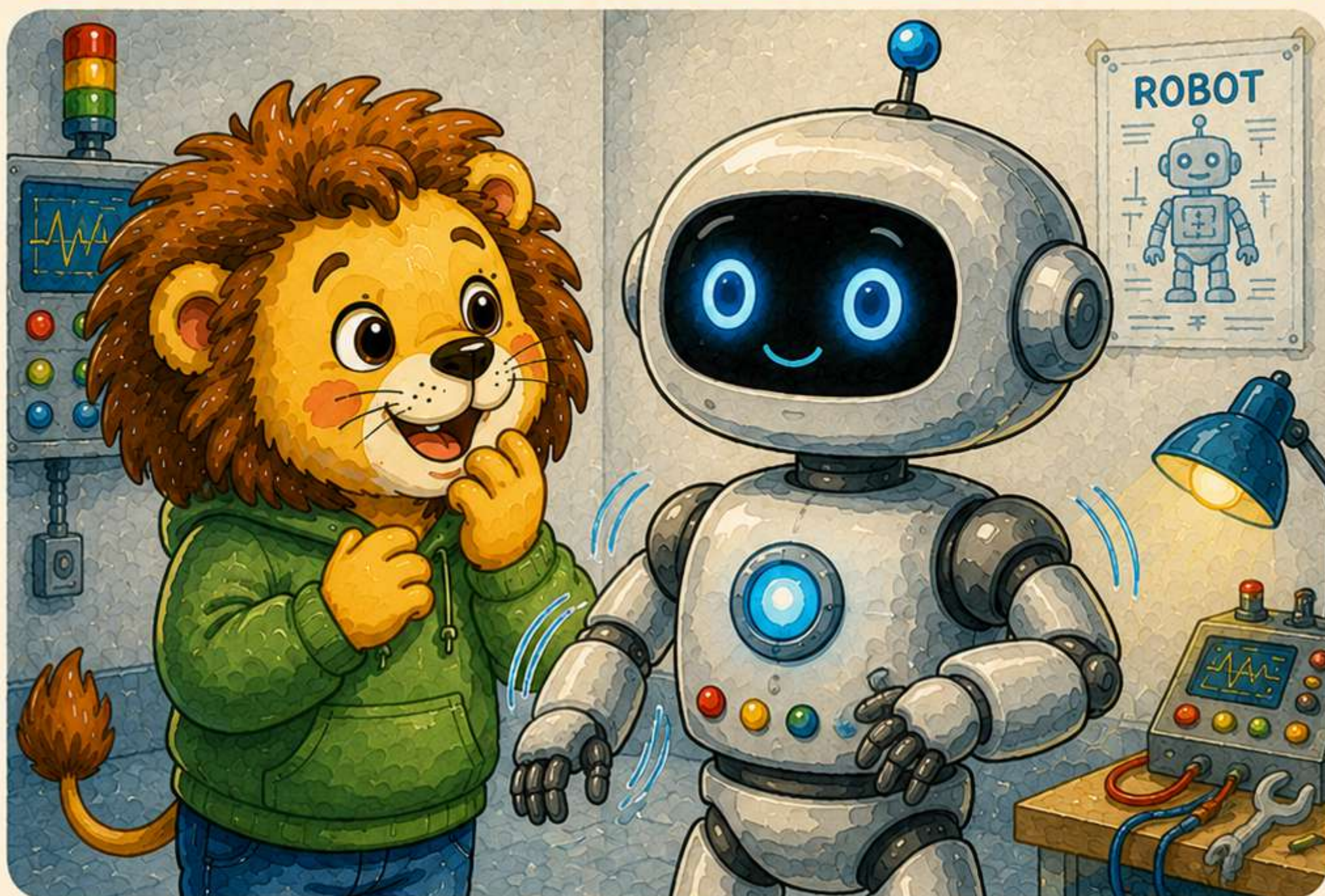
Its eyes glowed bright blue.

The robot waved at Leo slowly.

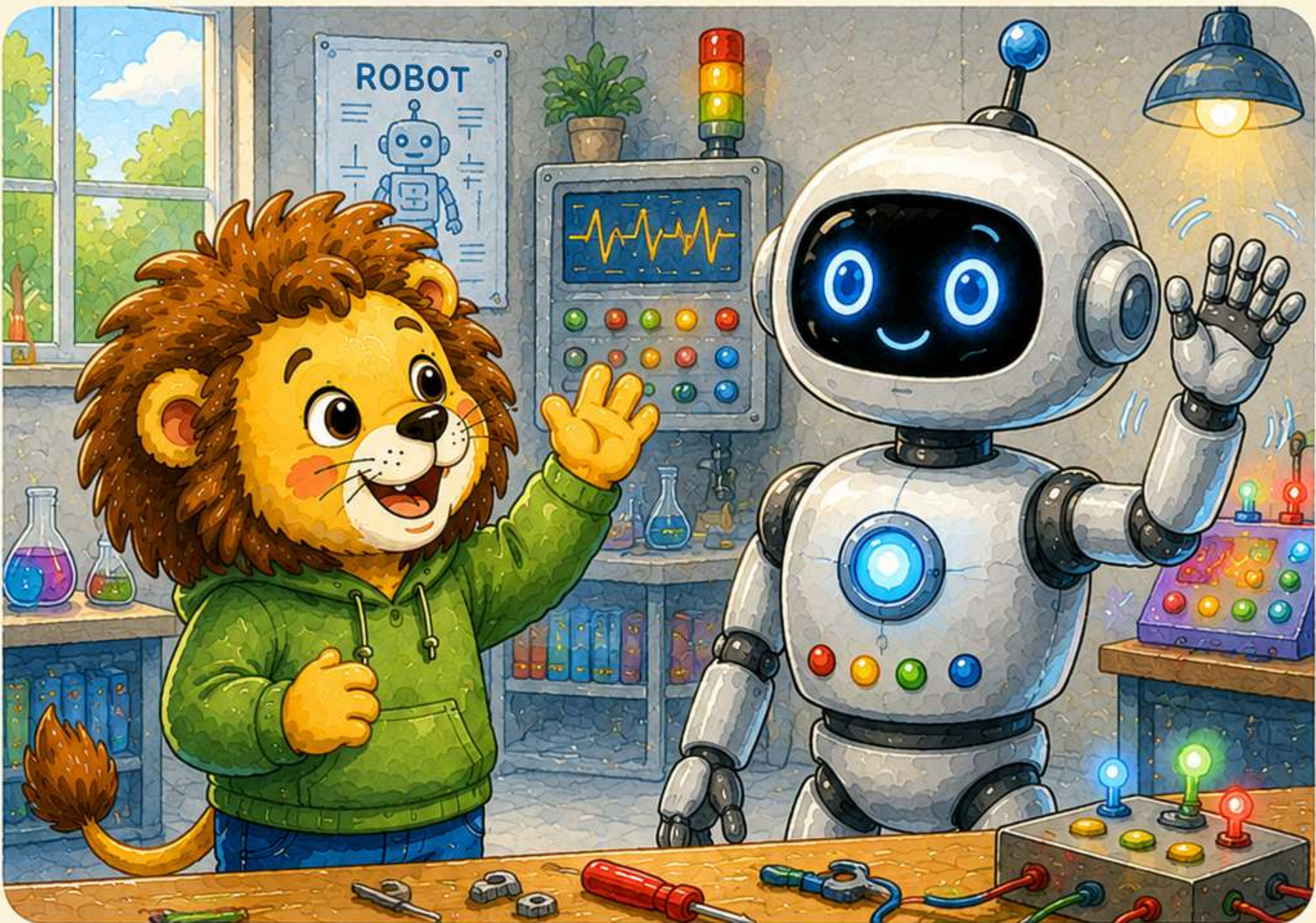


It made soft beeping sounds.

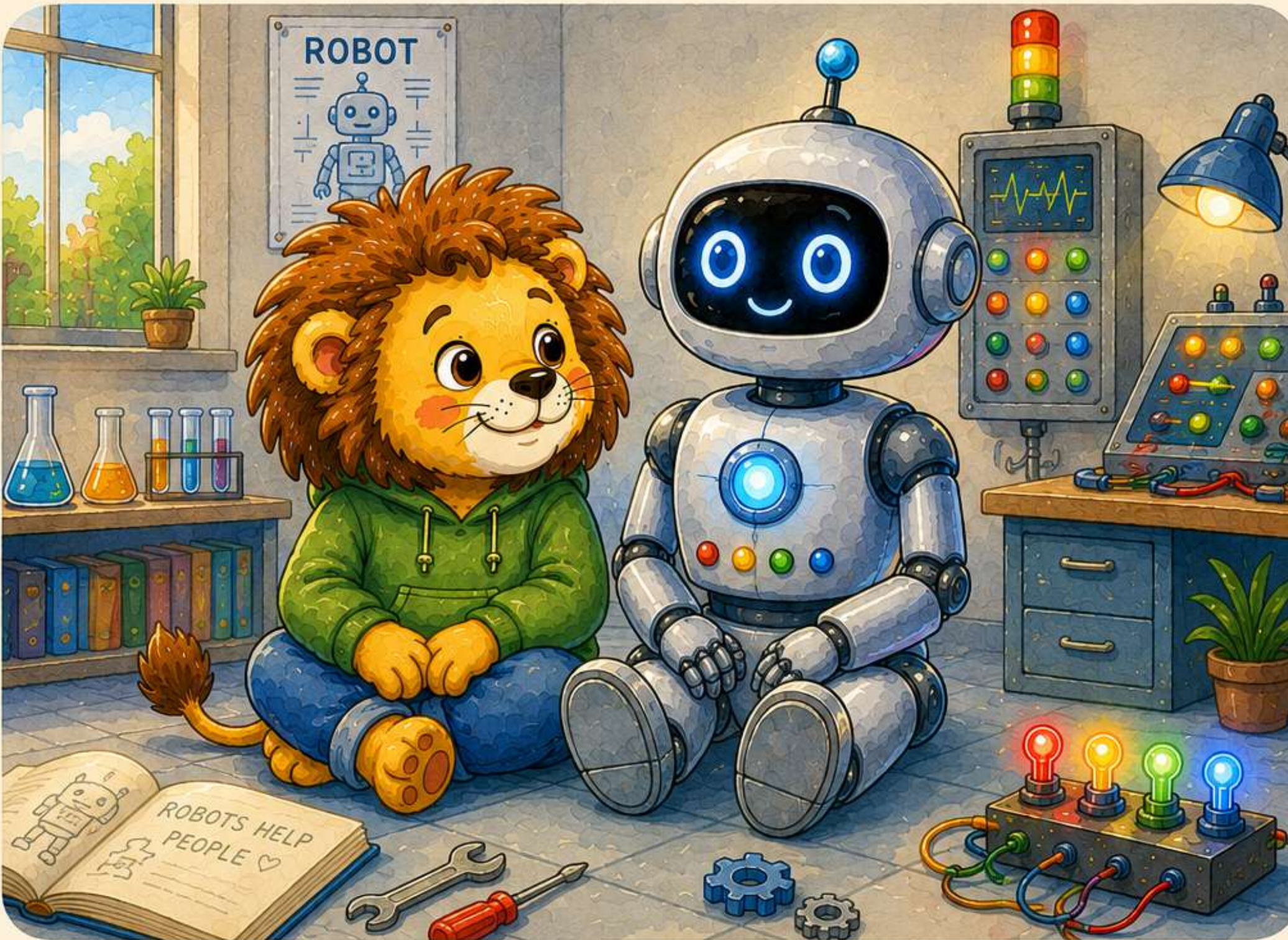

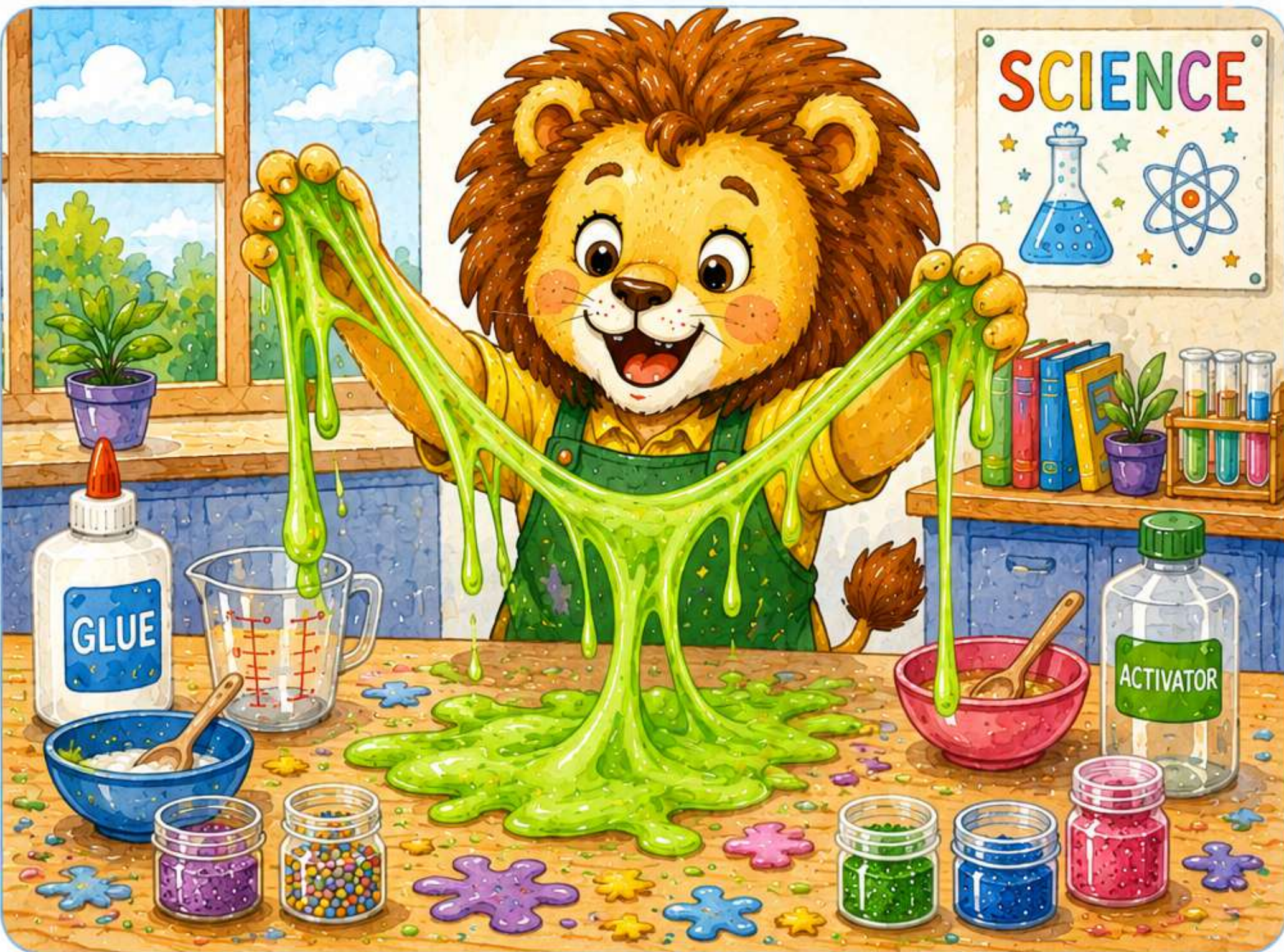

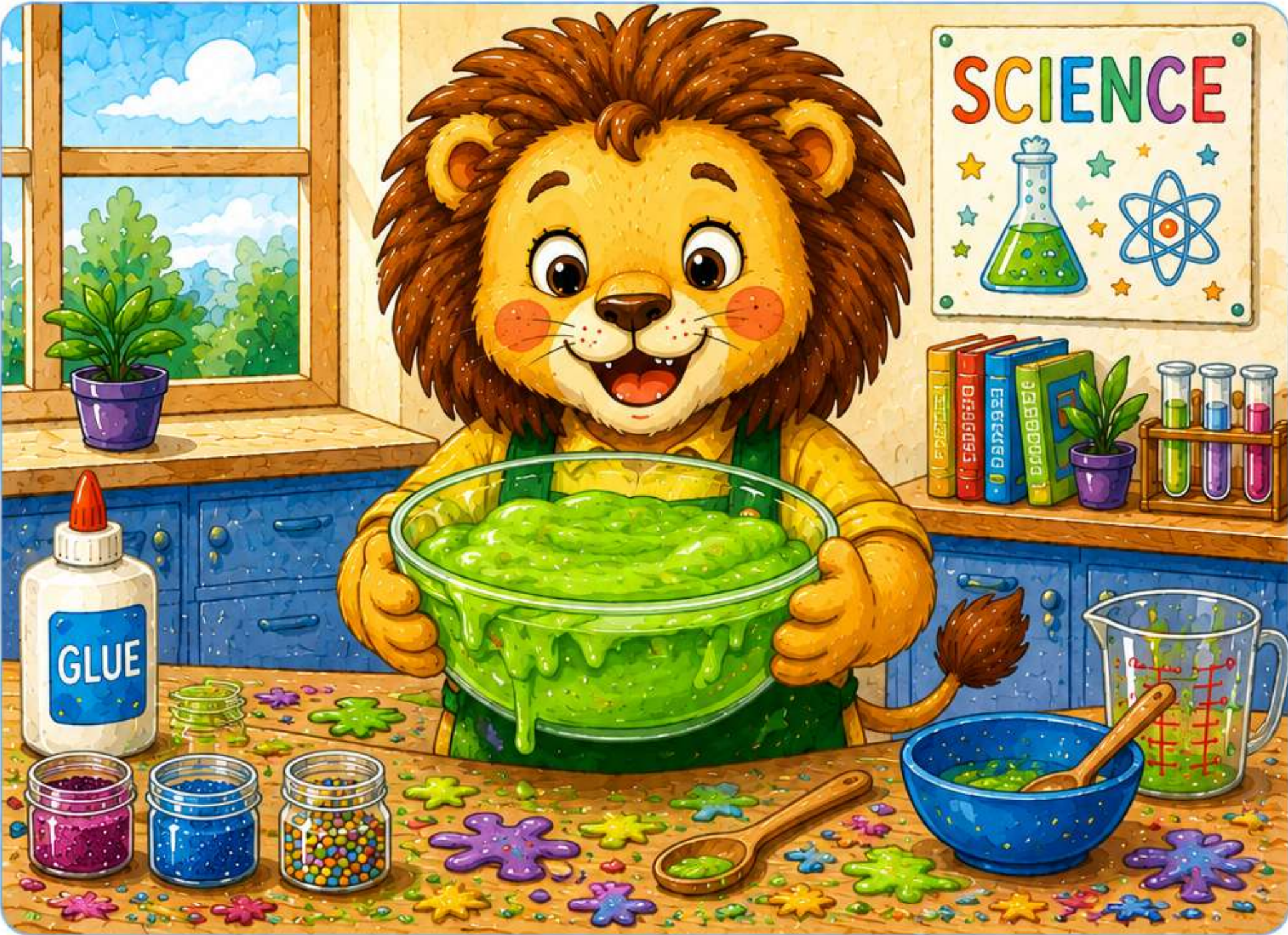
