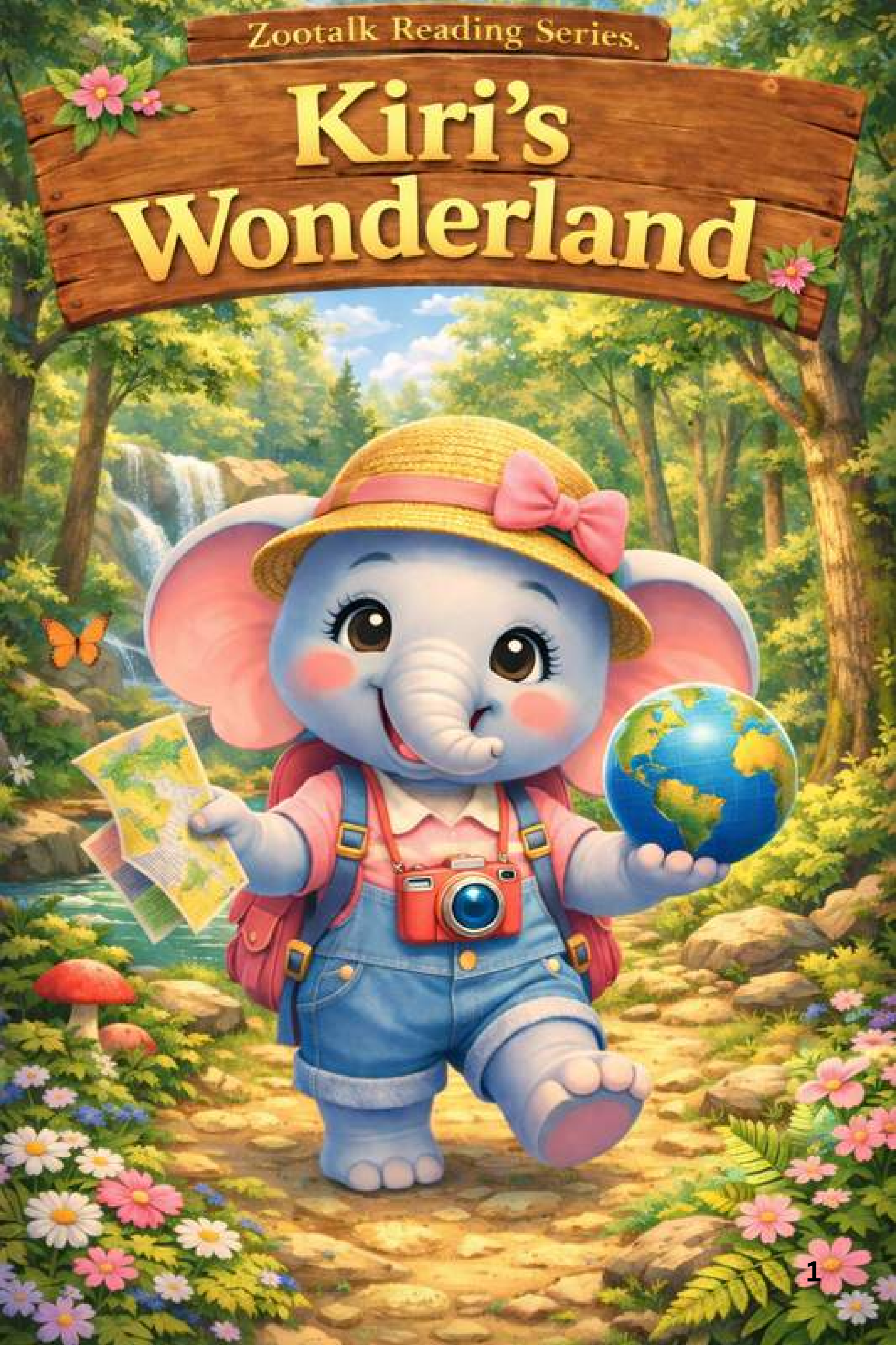


Zootalk Reading Series.

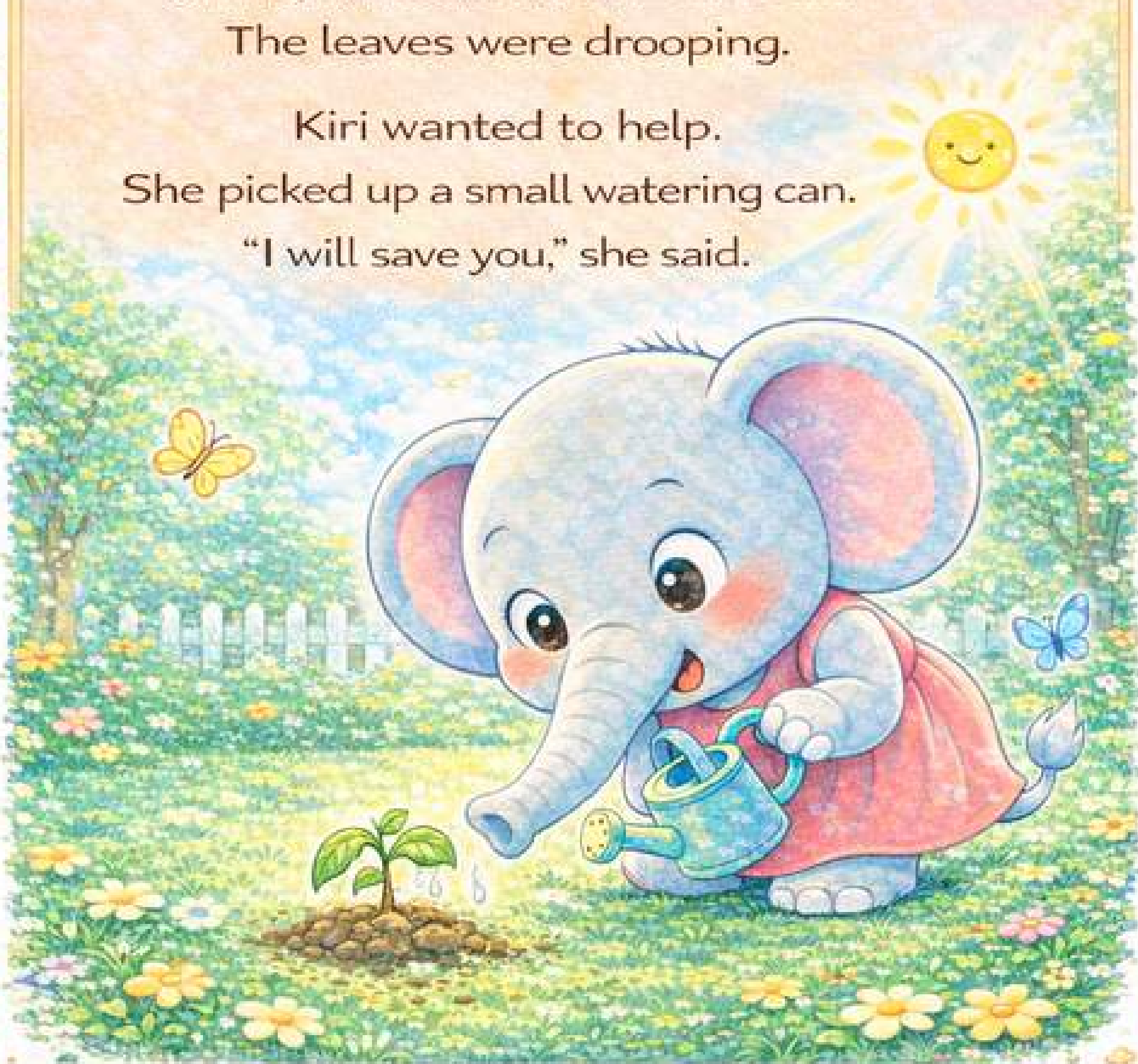

The tiny plant stood up a little.

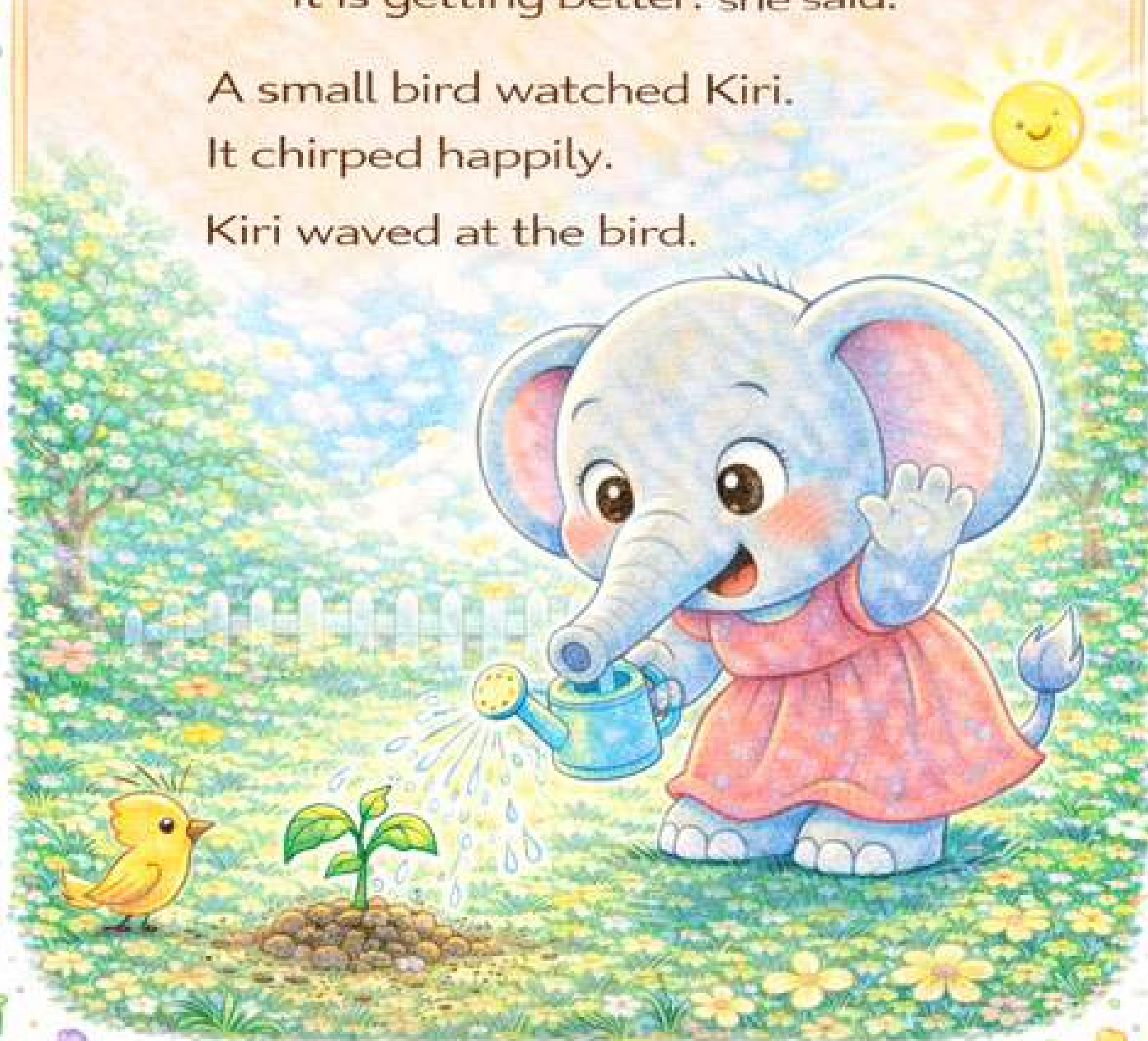
Kiri clapped her feet.

She covered it with a tiny leaf hat.

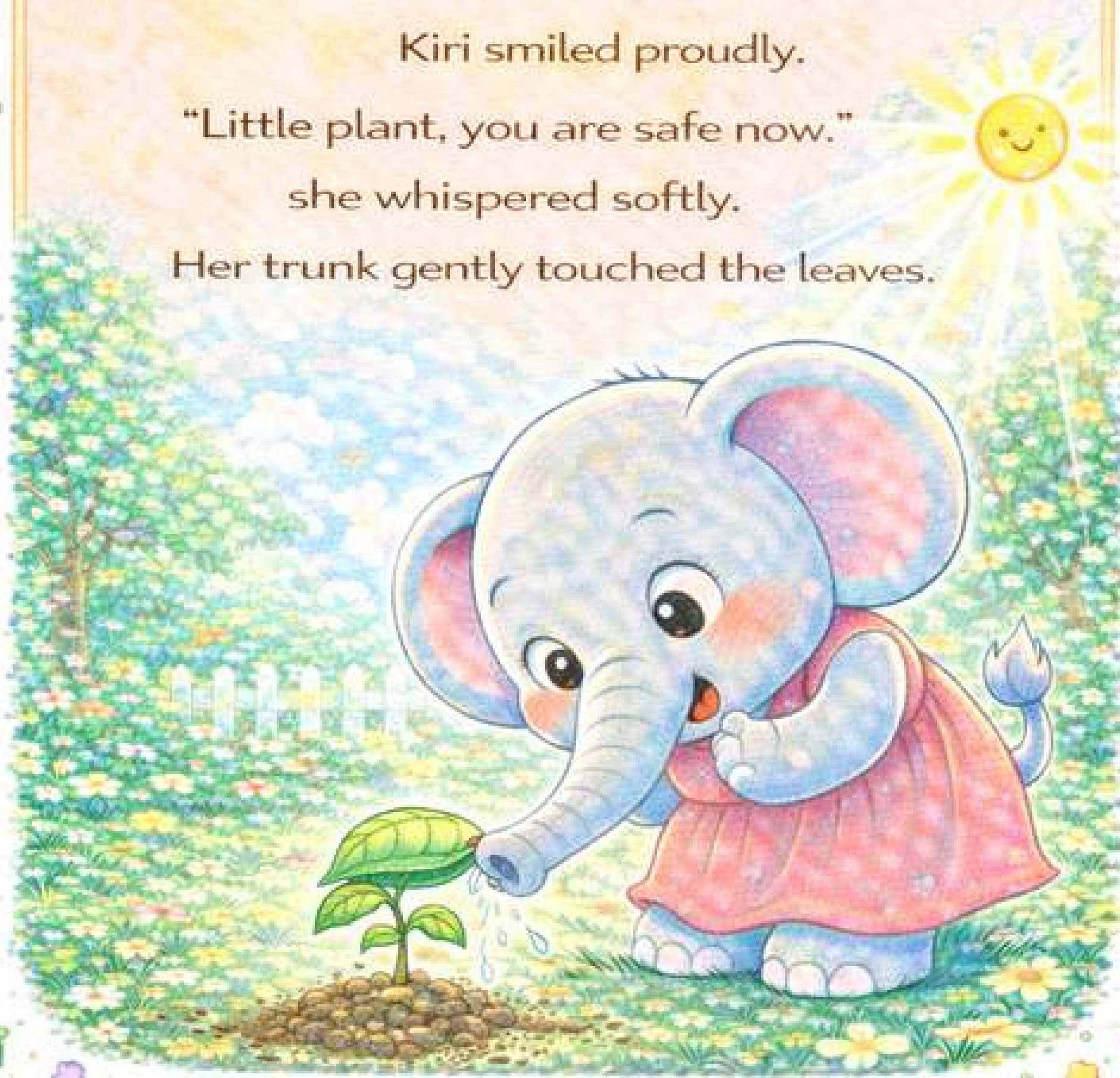
The sun warmed the plant gently.

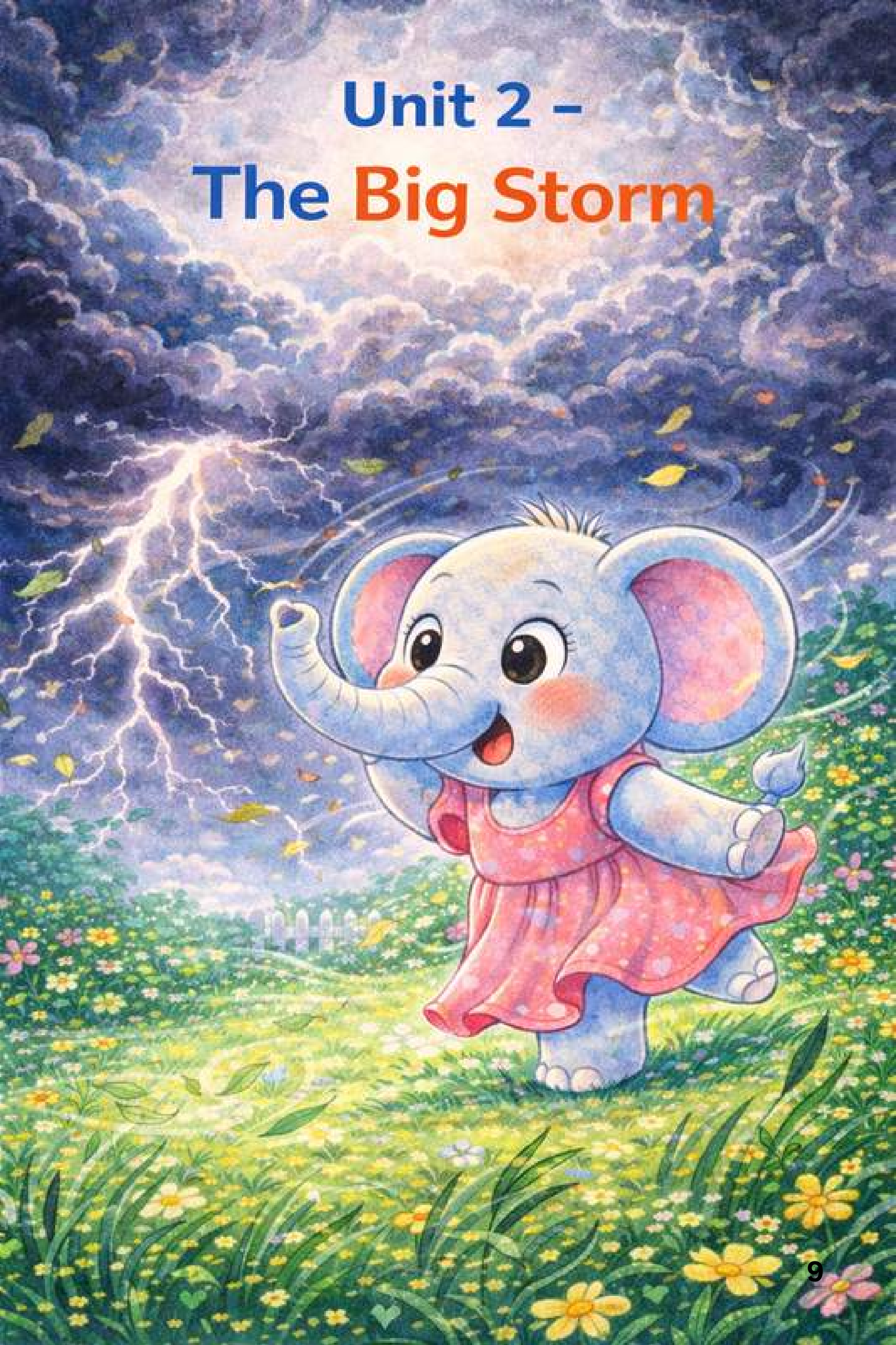

"The storm is over, and everything looks bright!"

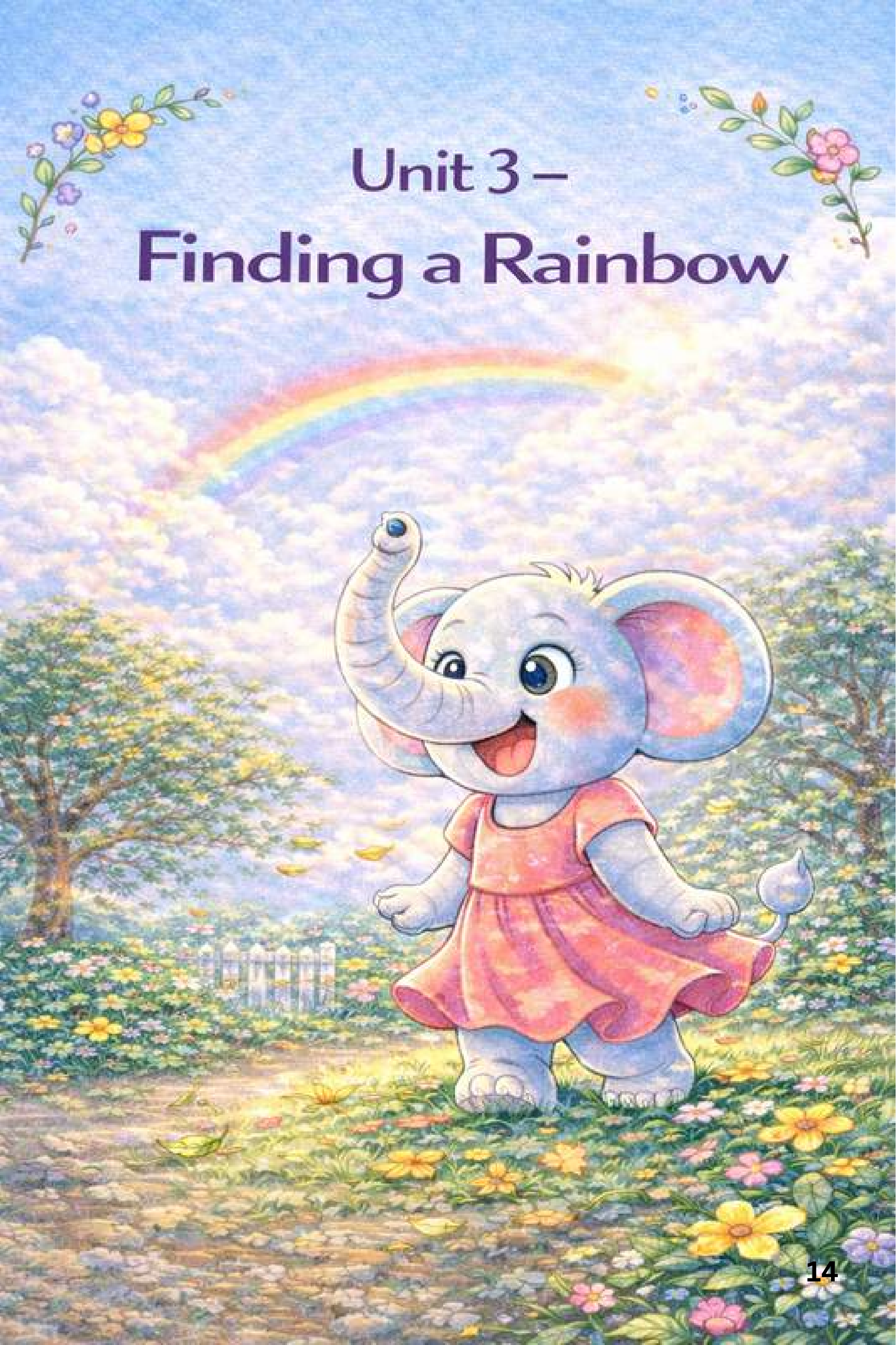

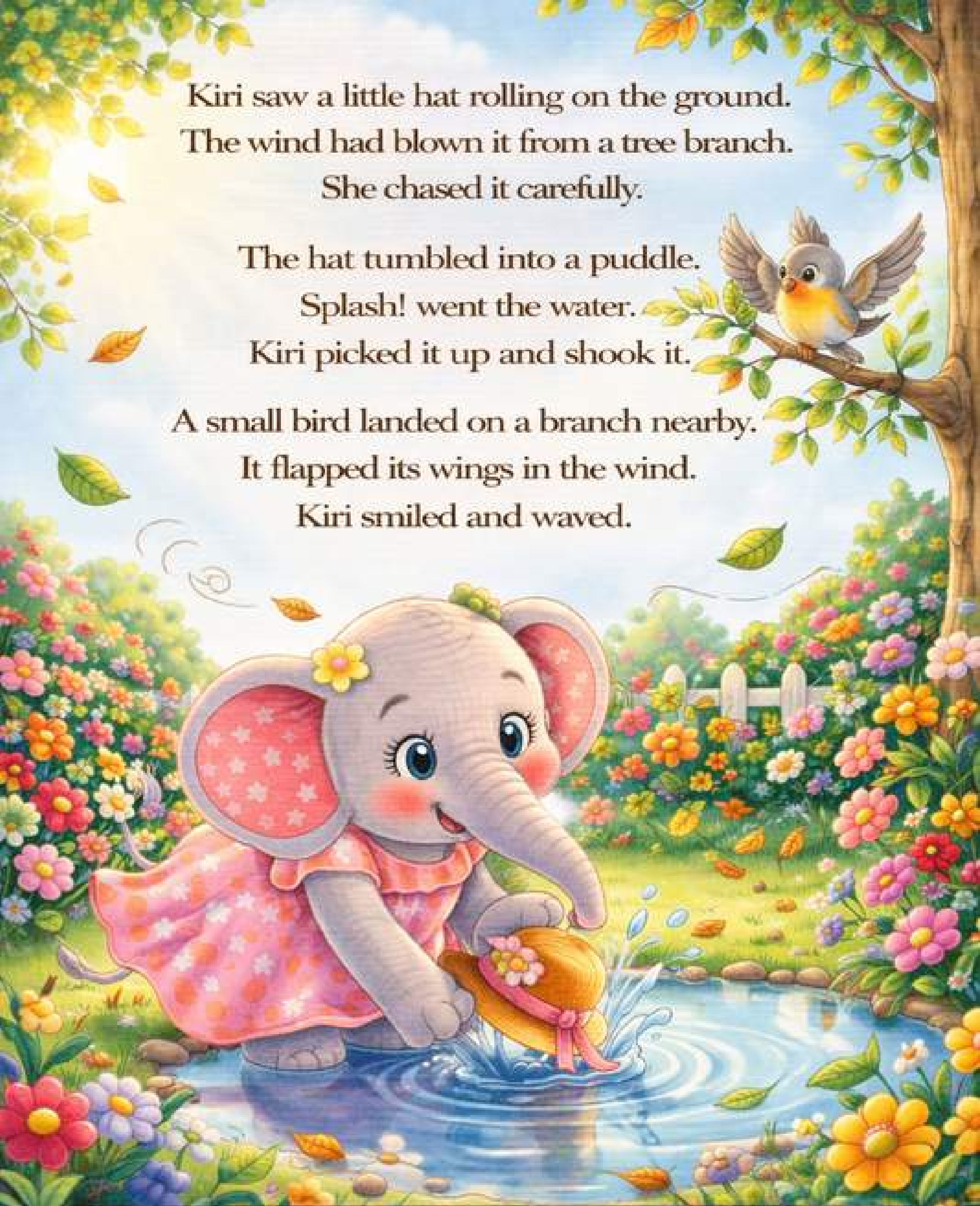

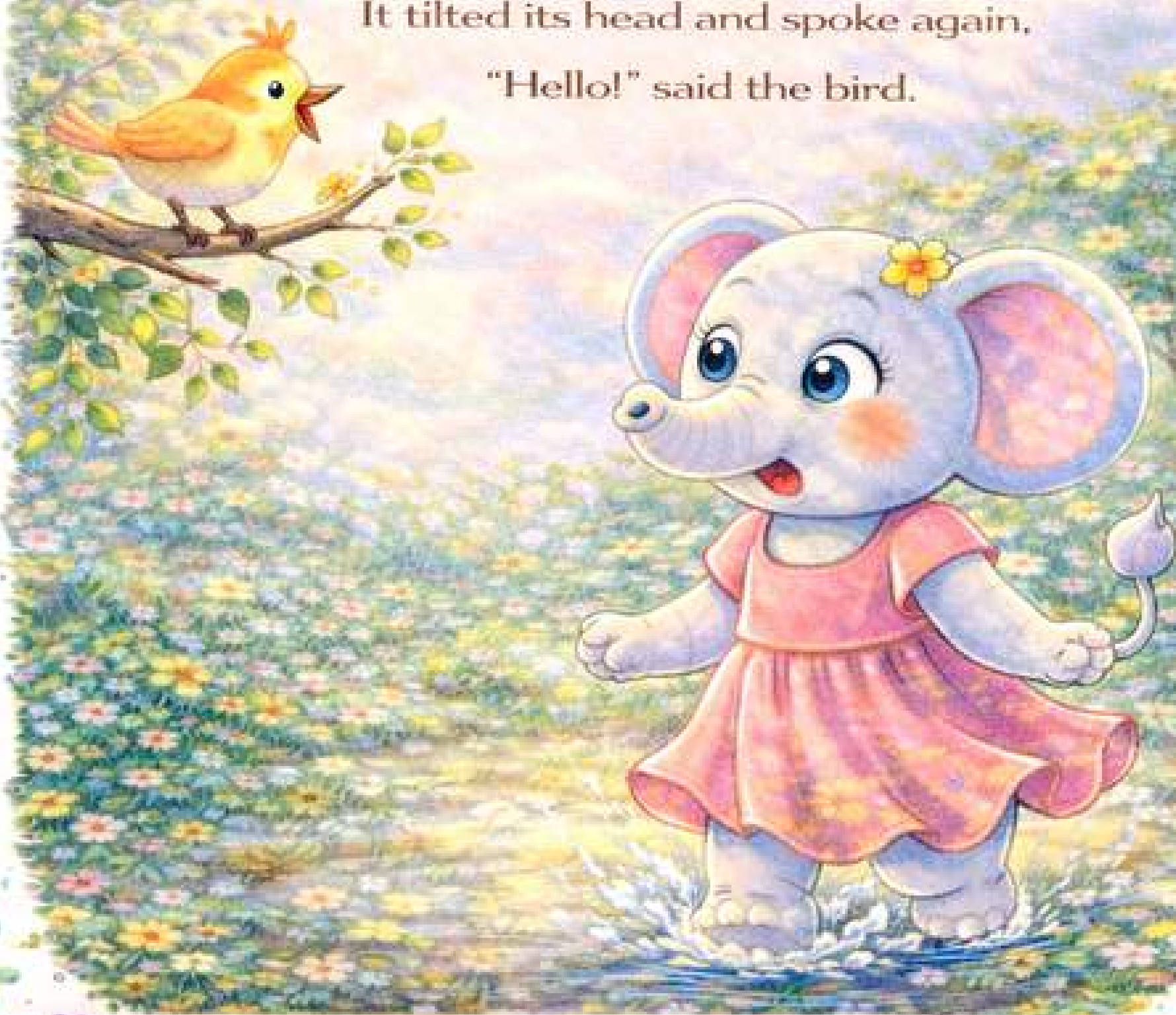
Unit 5 • The Talking Bird

What did Kiri hear in the trees?



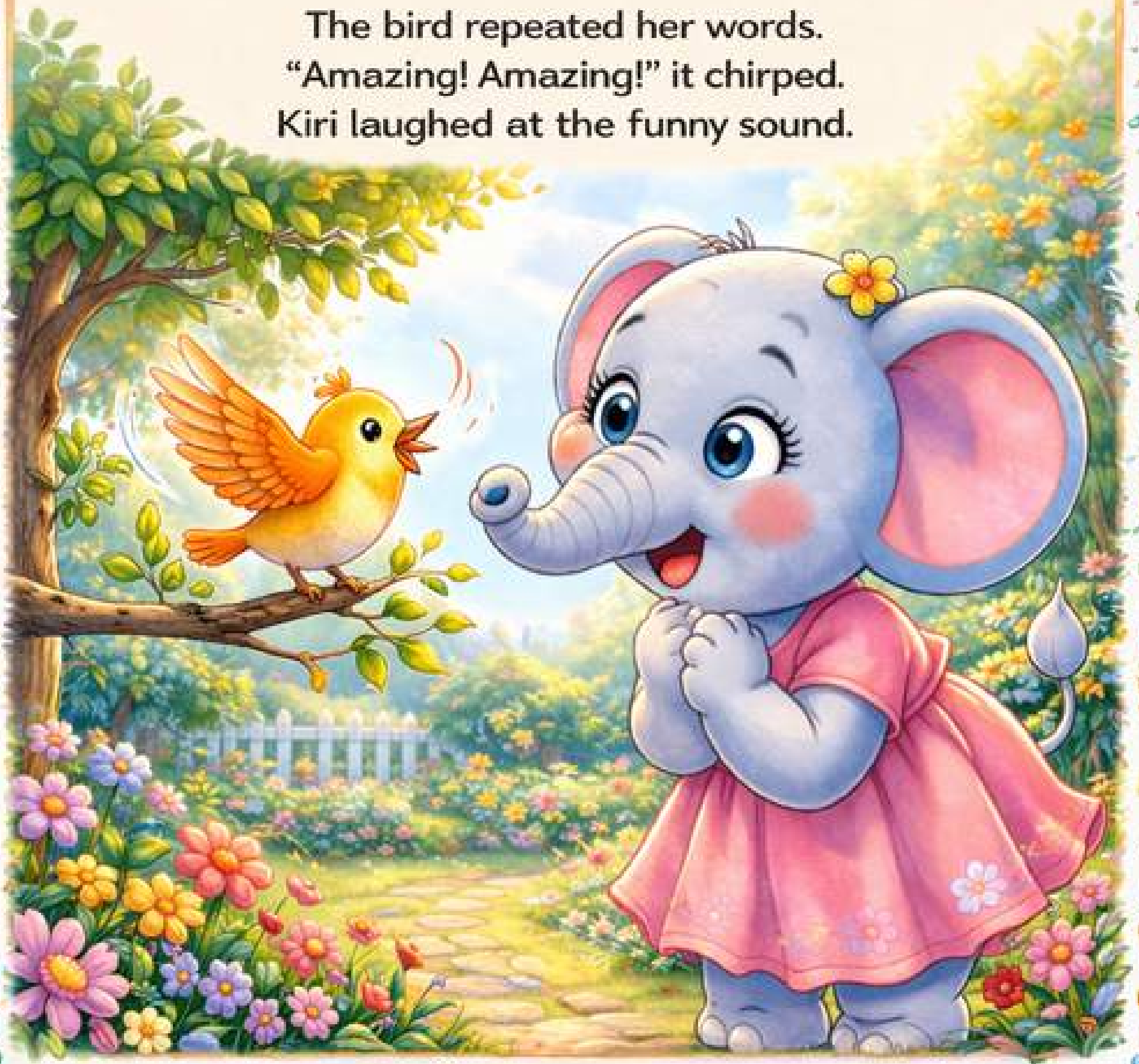

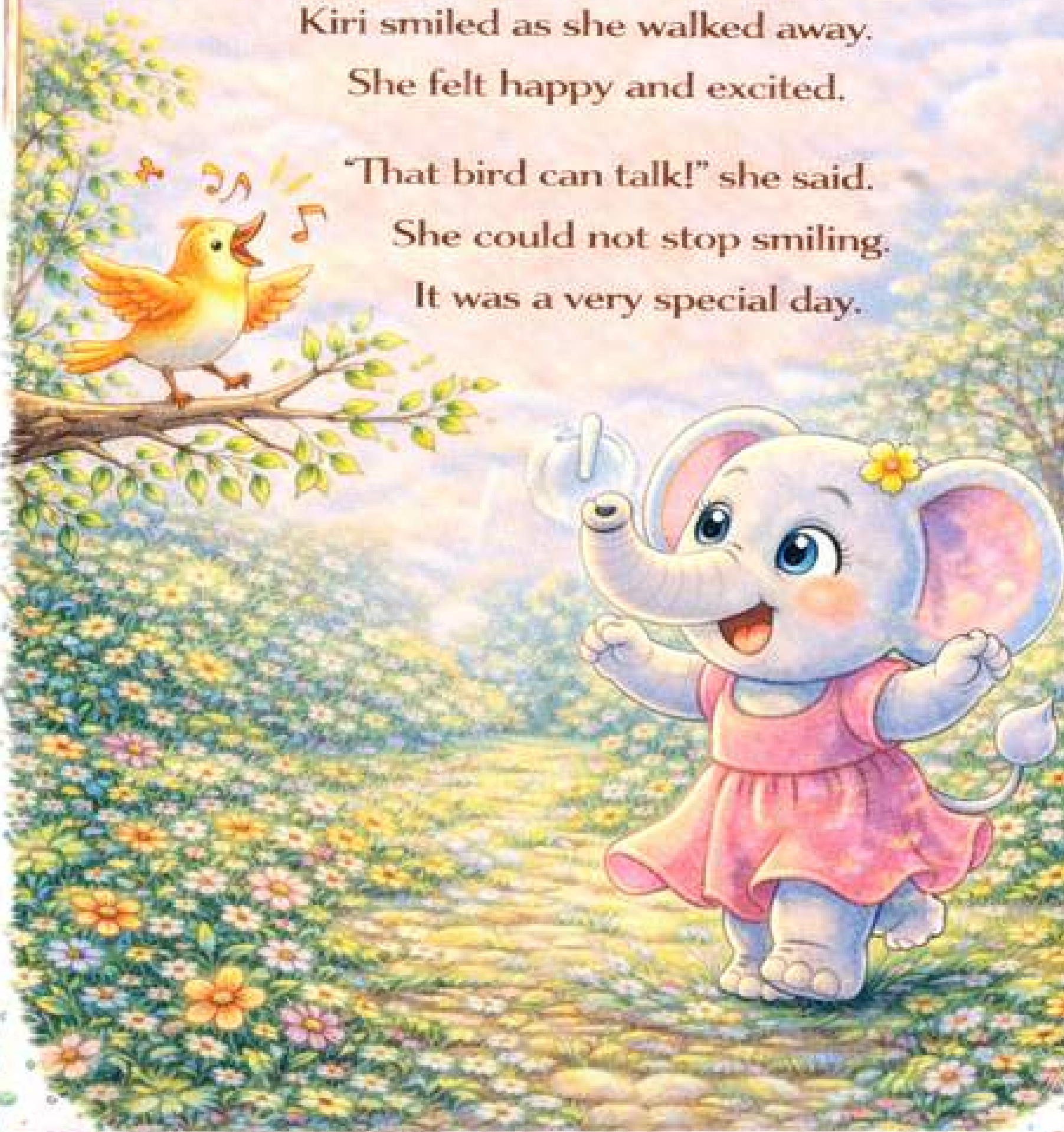

It danced in the wind.



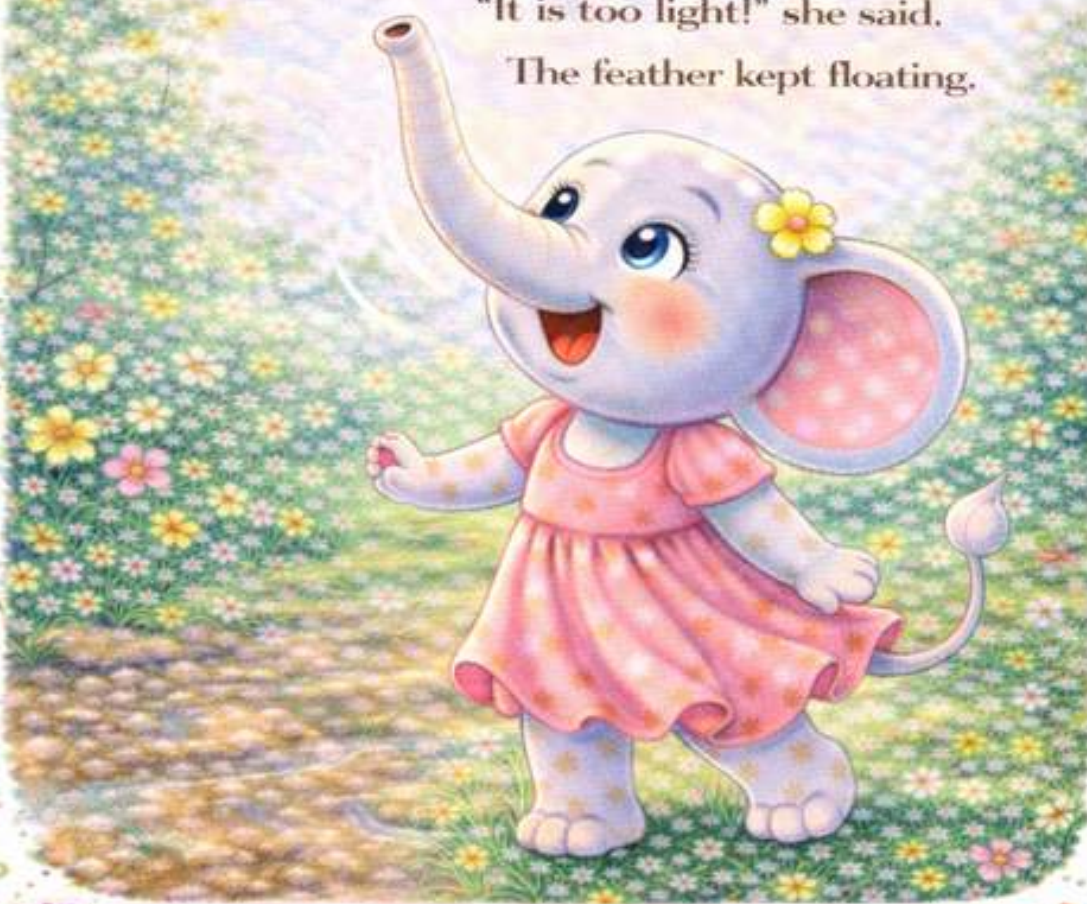

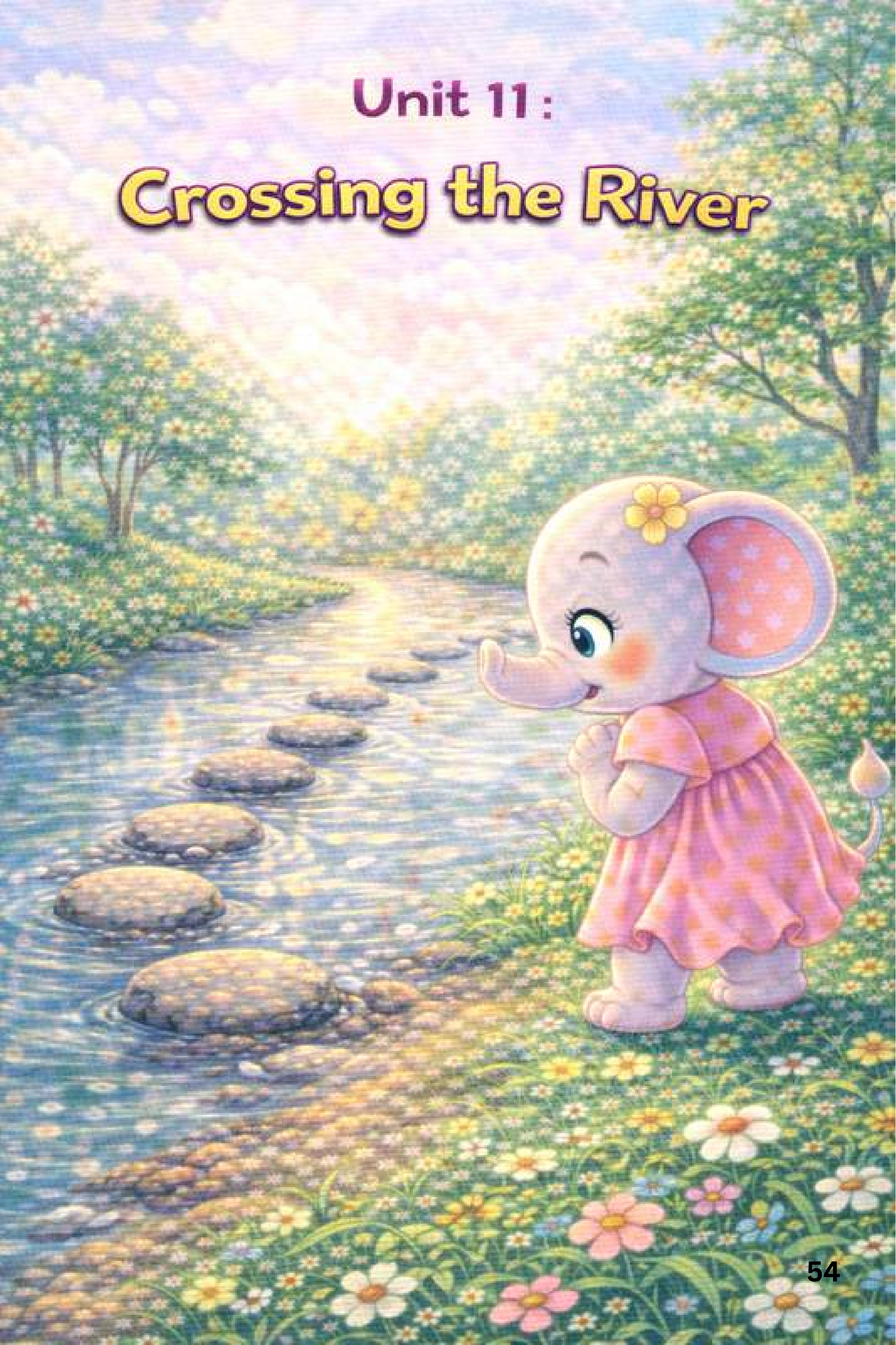

They slid and spun together.

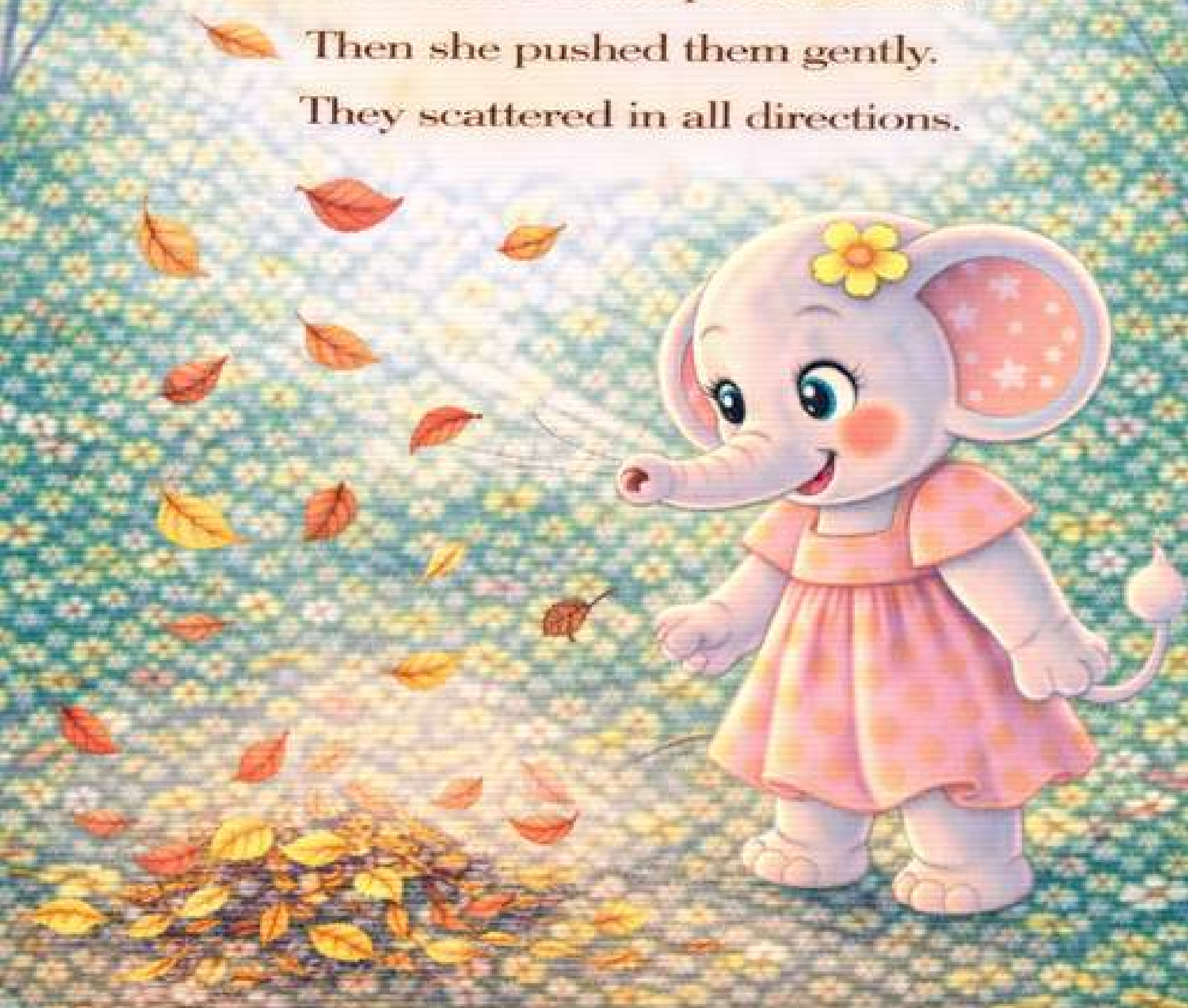
She walked through the leaves slowly.

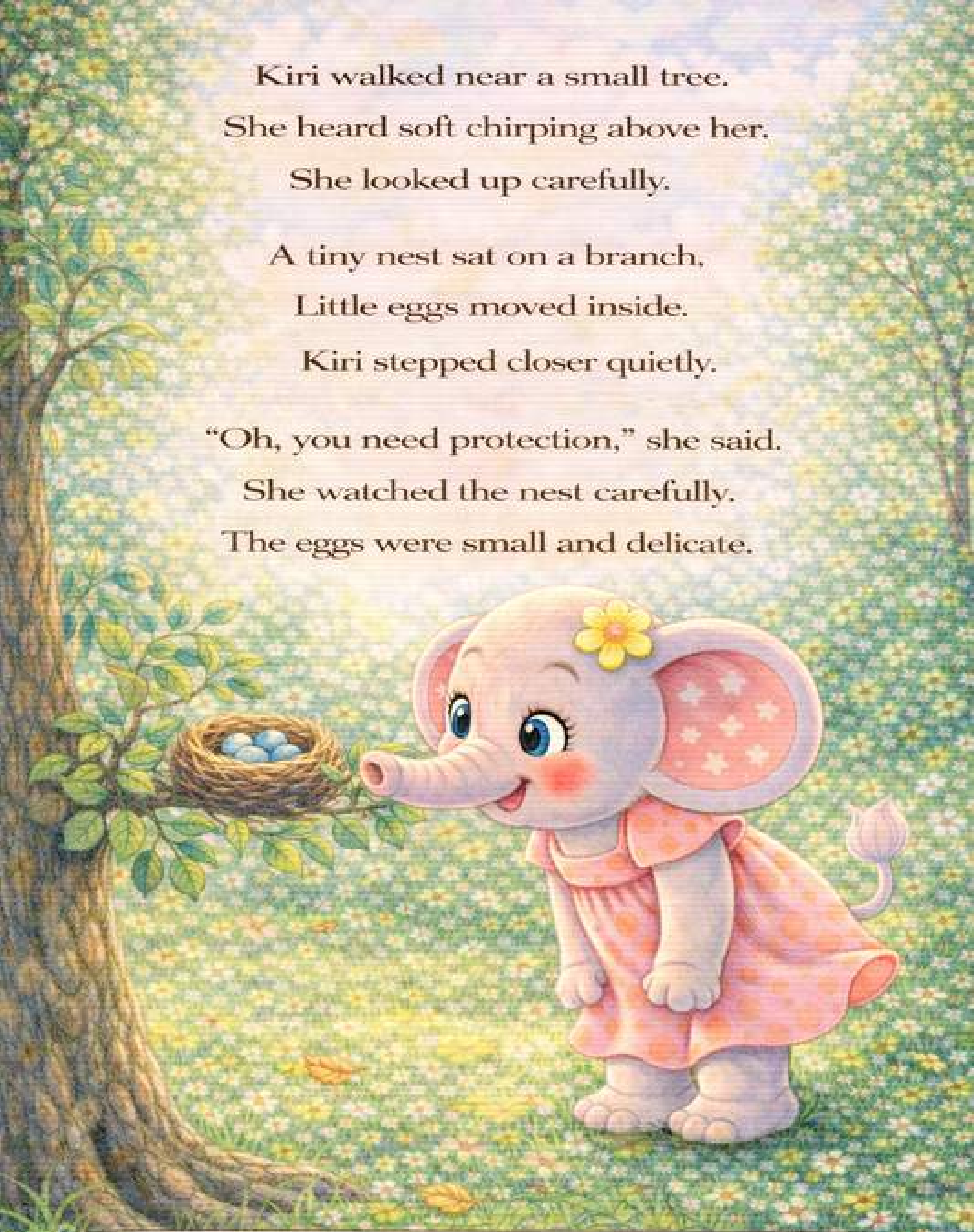

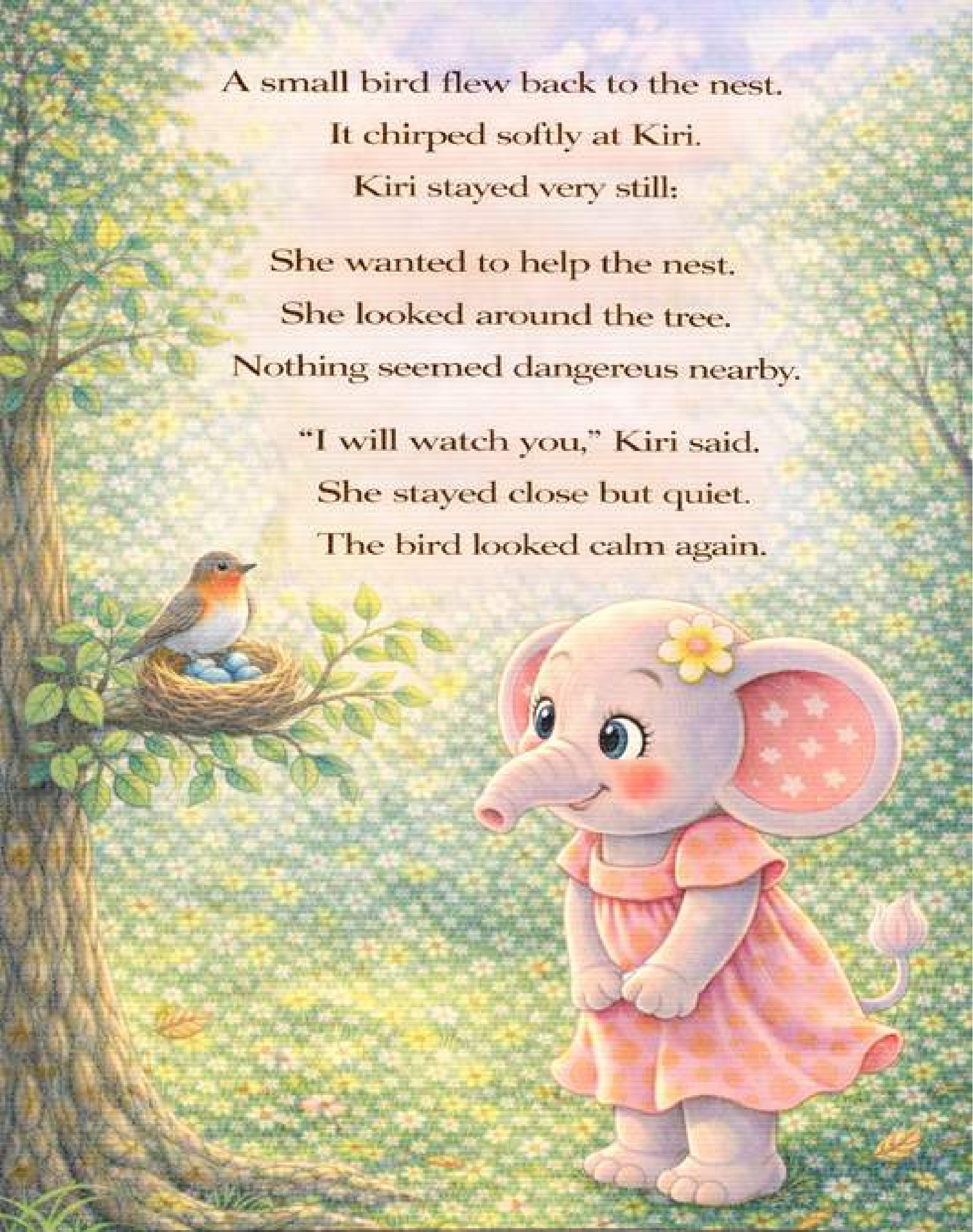
