- 7레벨 Kiri (과거형을 사용하며, 깊은 사고력 관련 포함)

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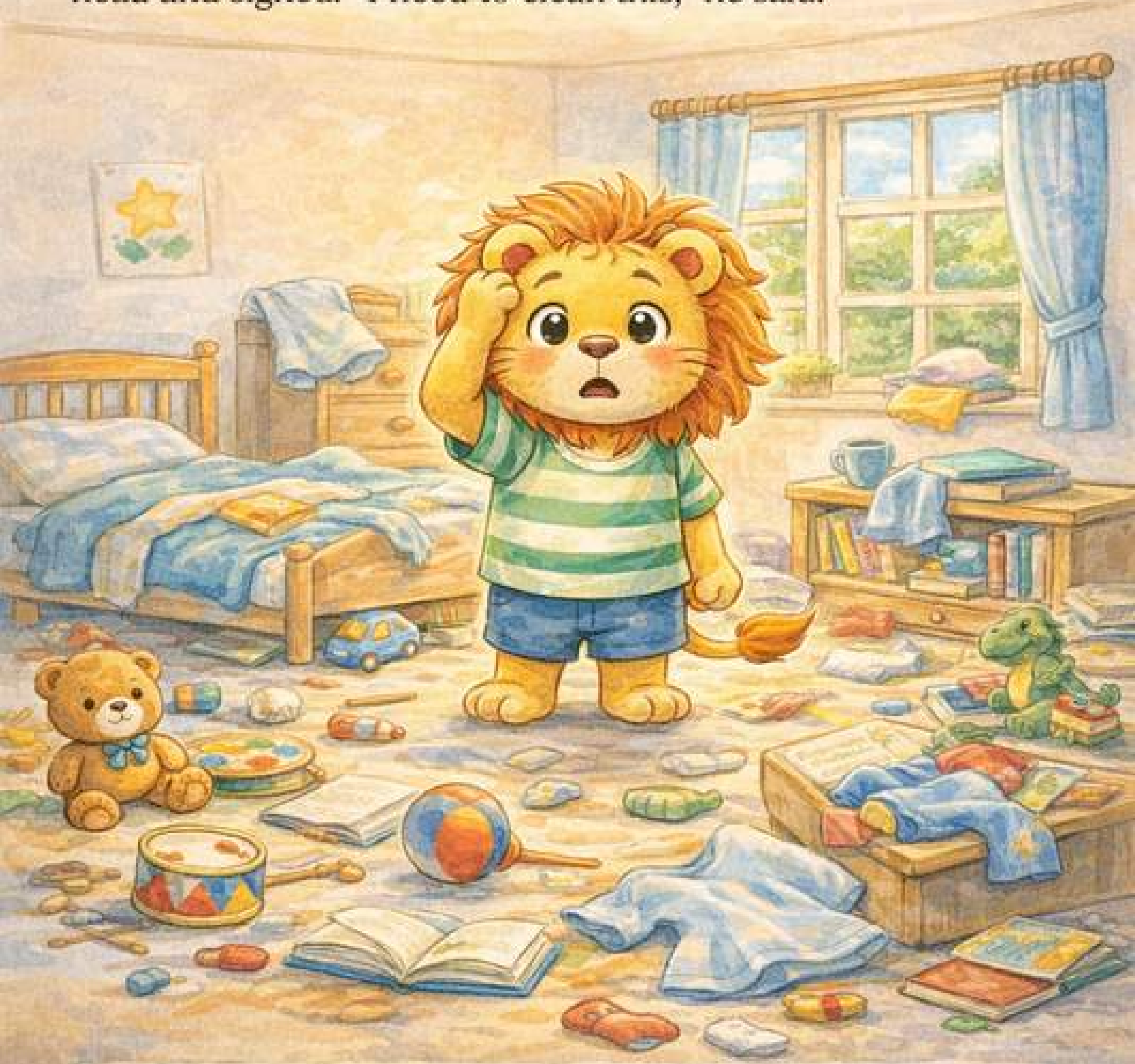
Unit 1 :

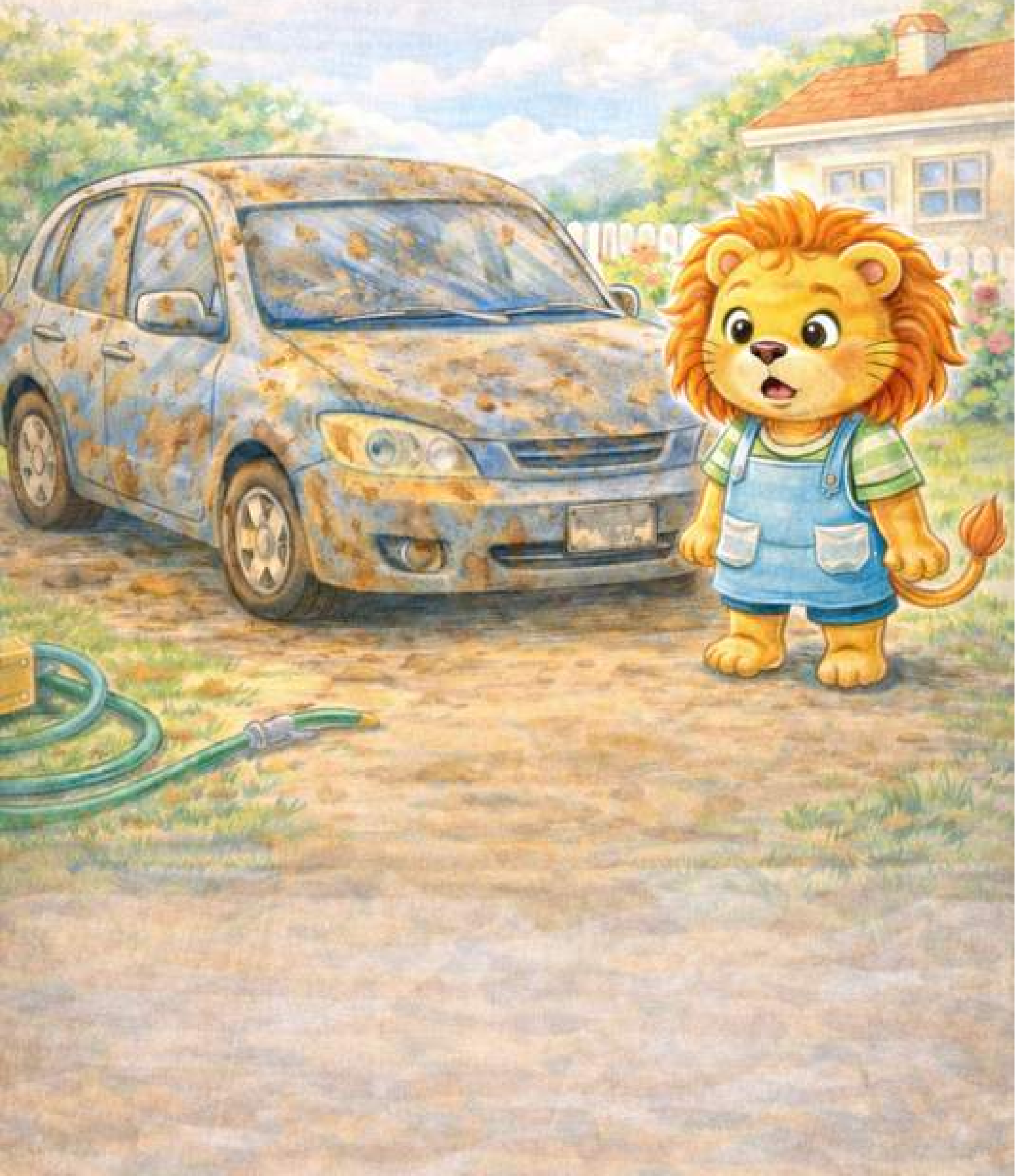

Leo walked outside and saw a car in the yard.

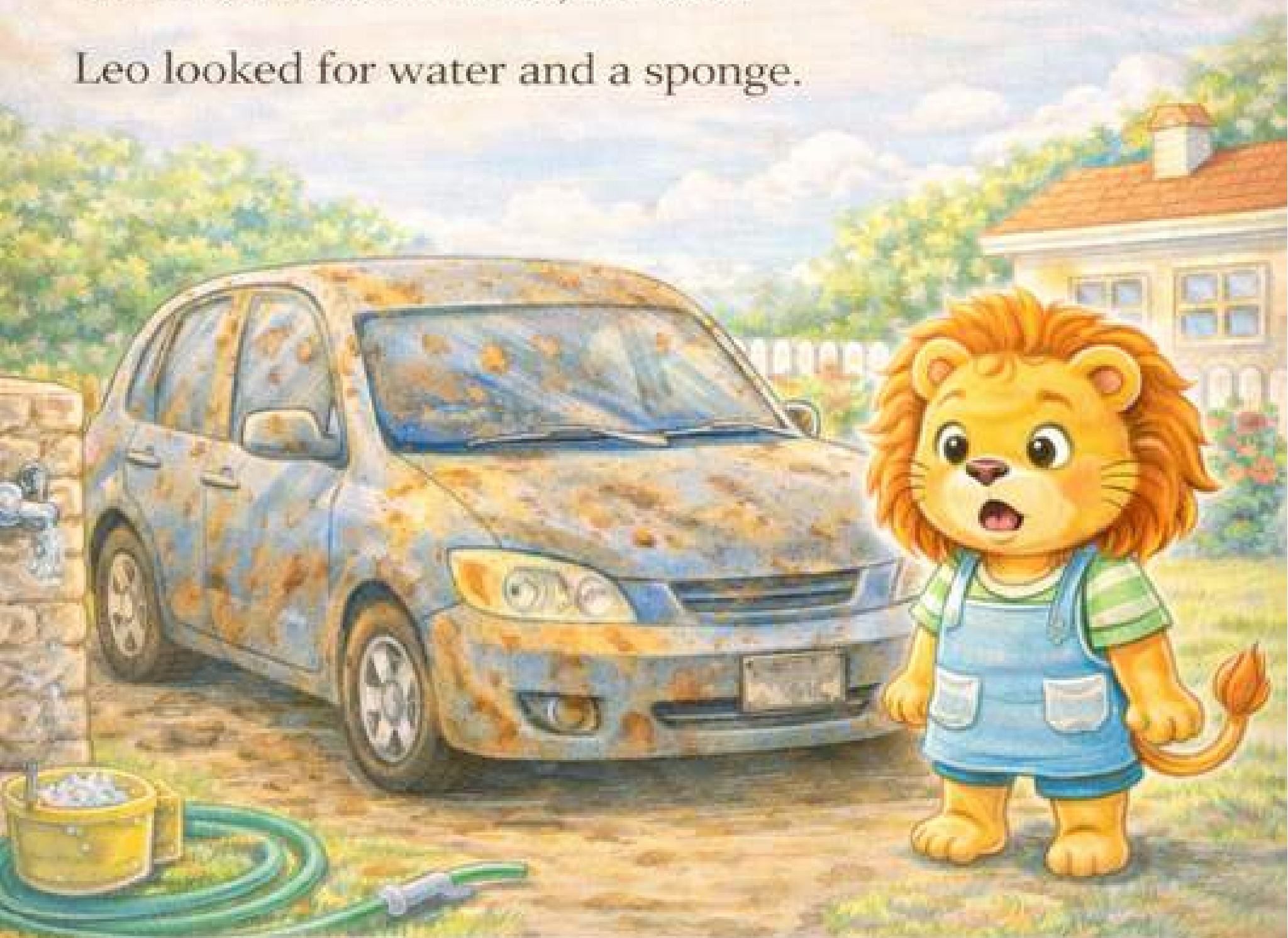
He stopped and looked closely.

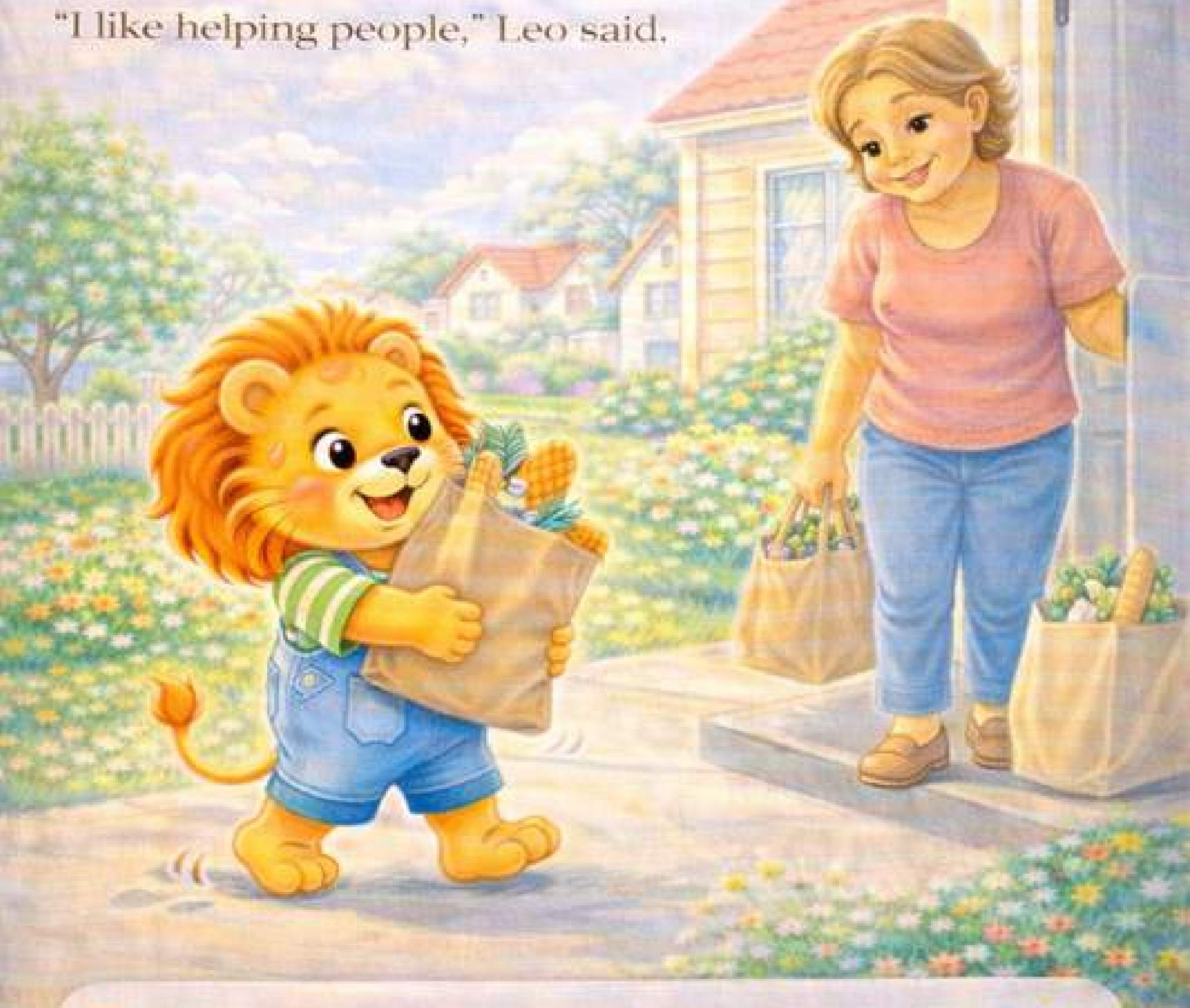

Leo found some gloves and a bag.

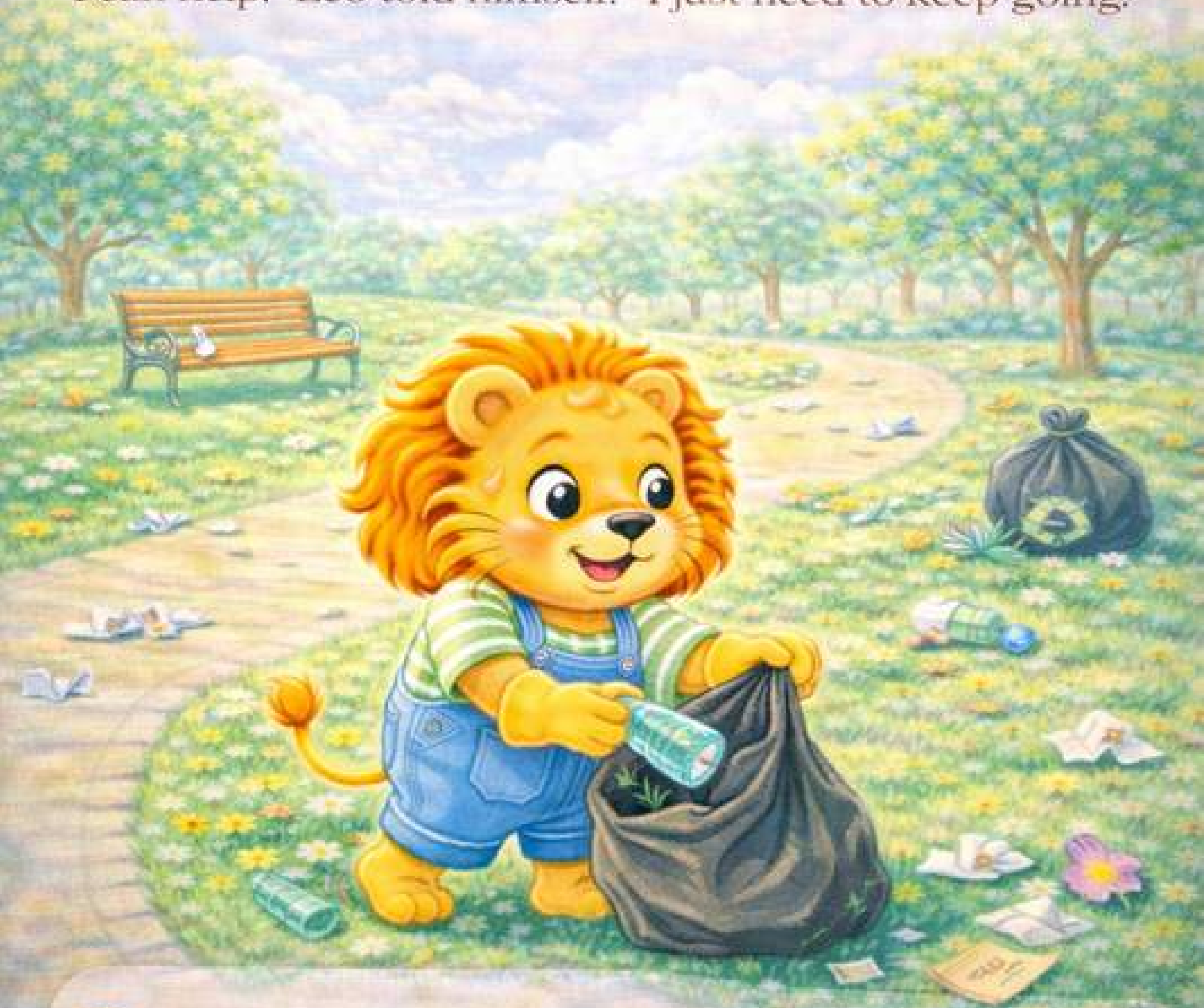
He put on the gloves and started picking up trash.

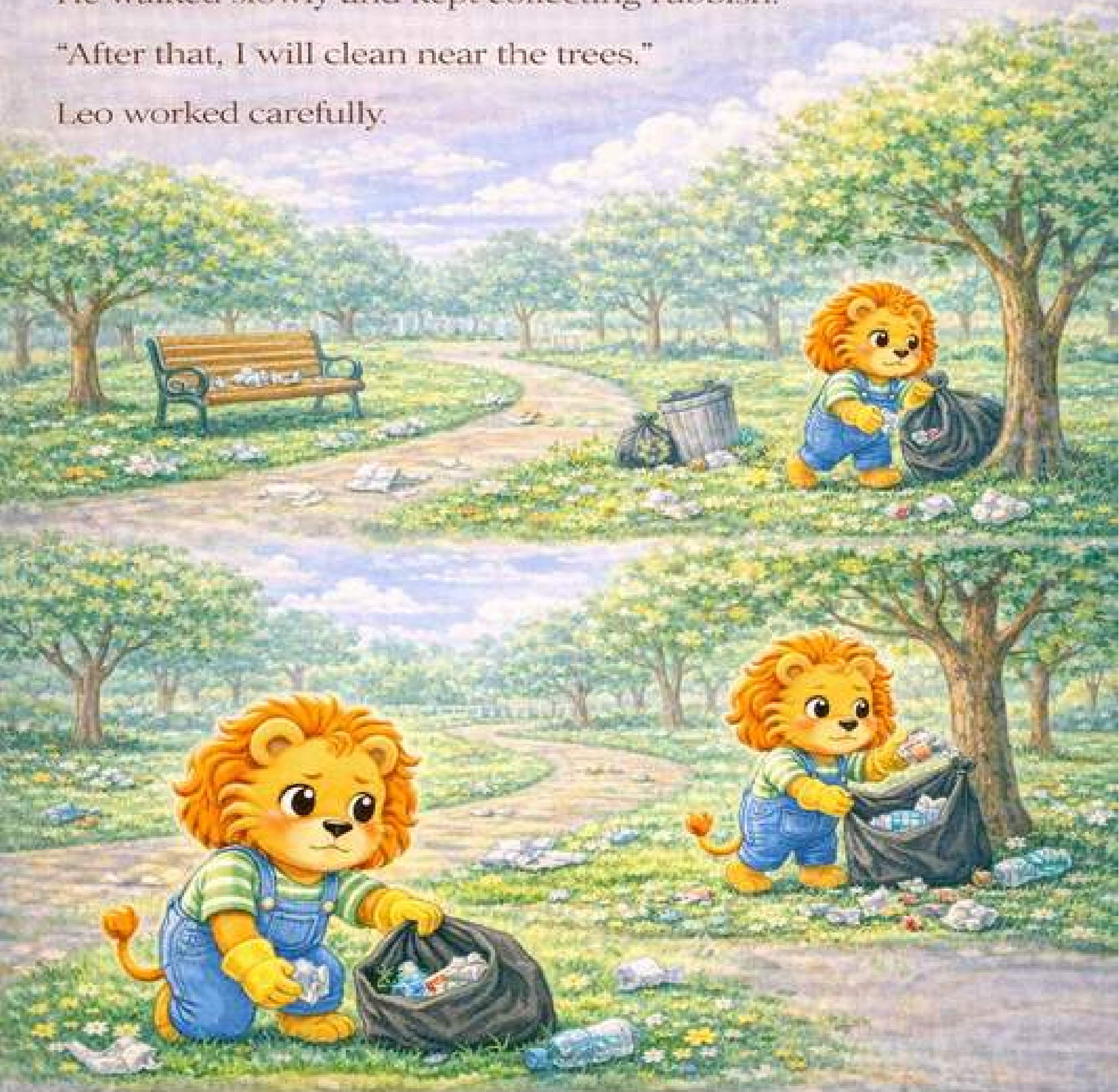

He stopped suddenly.

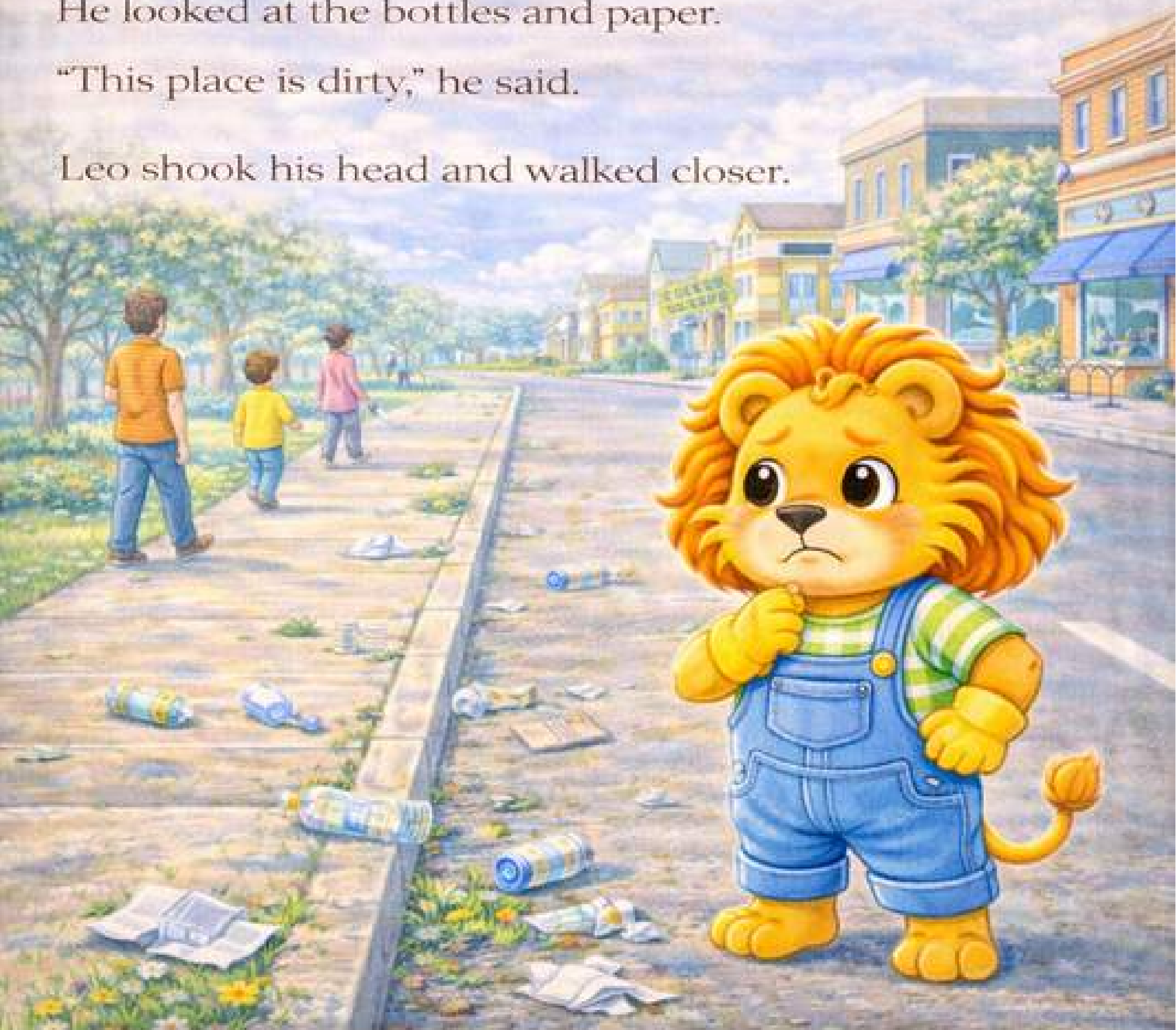
There was trash on the ground near the sidewalk.

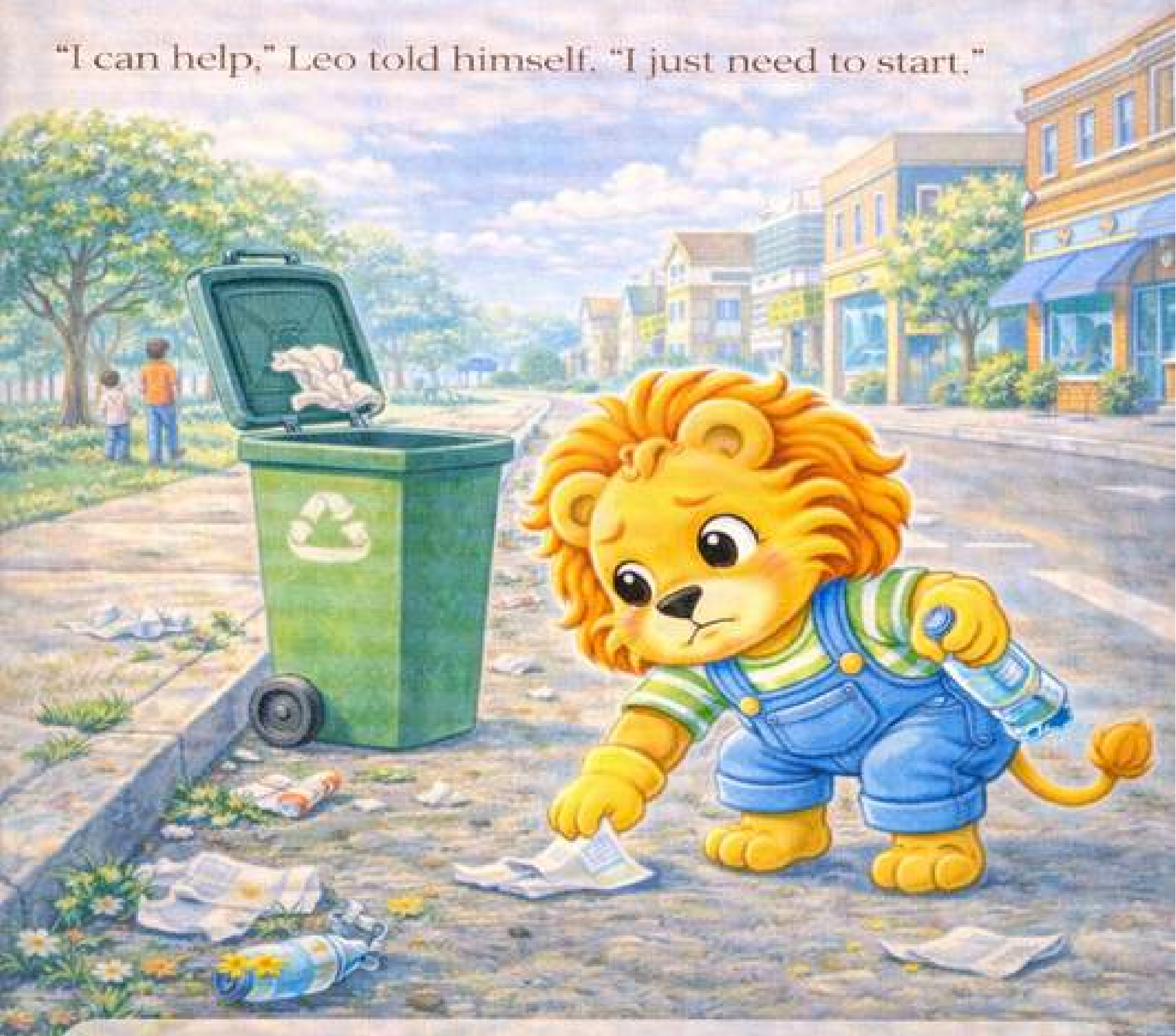
Leo bent down and picked up a piece of paper.

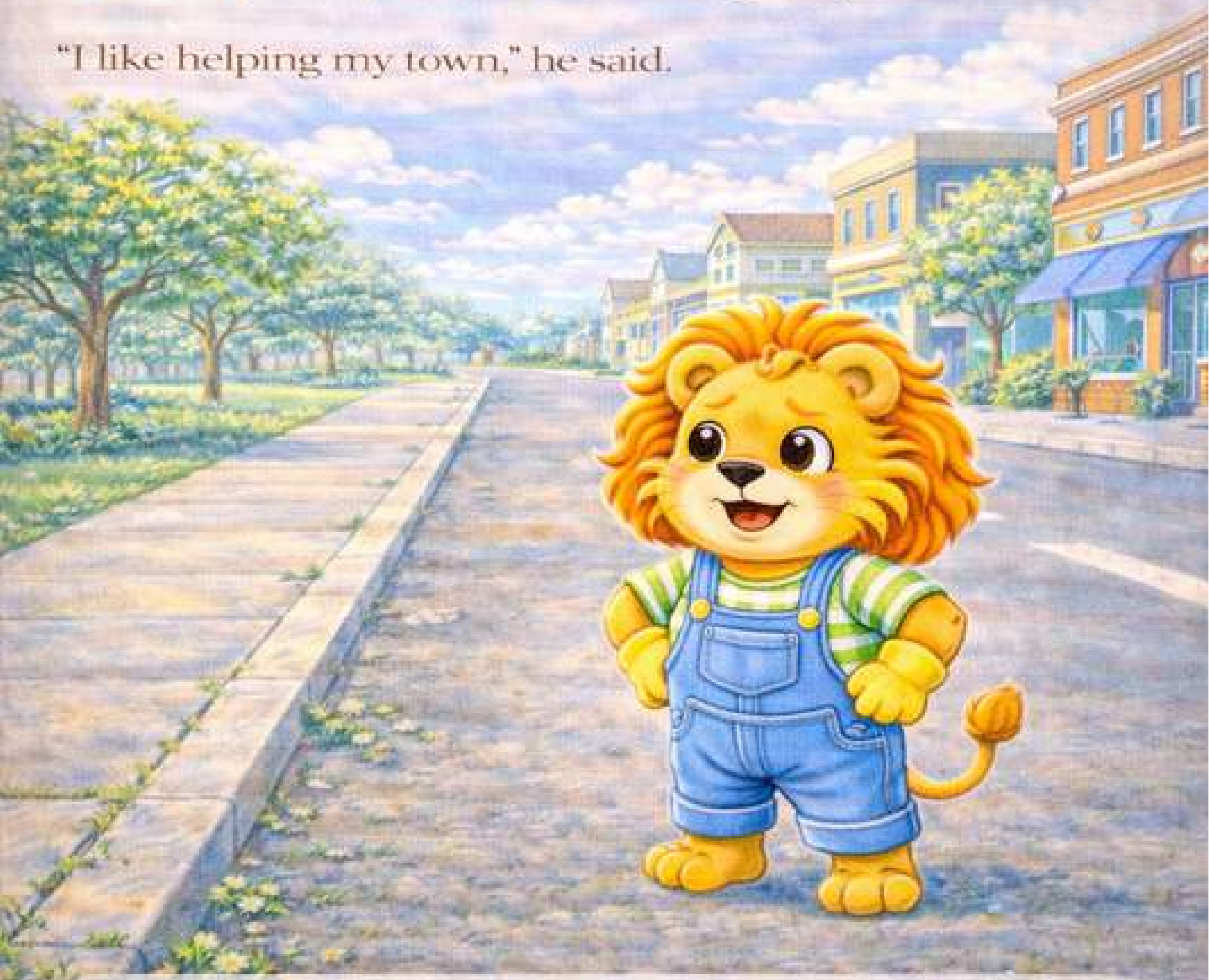

Sharing Food



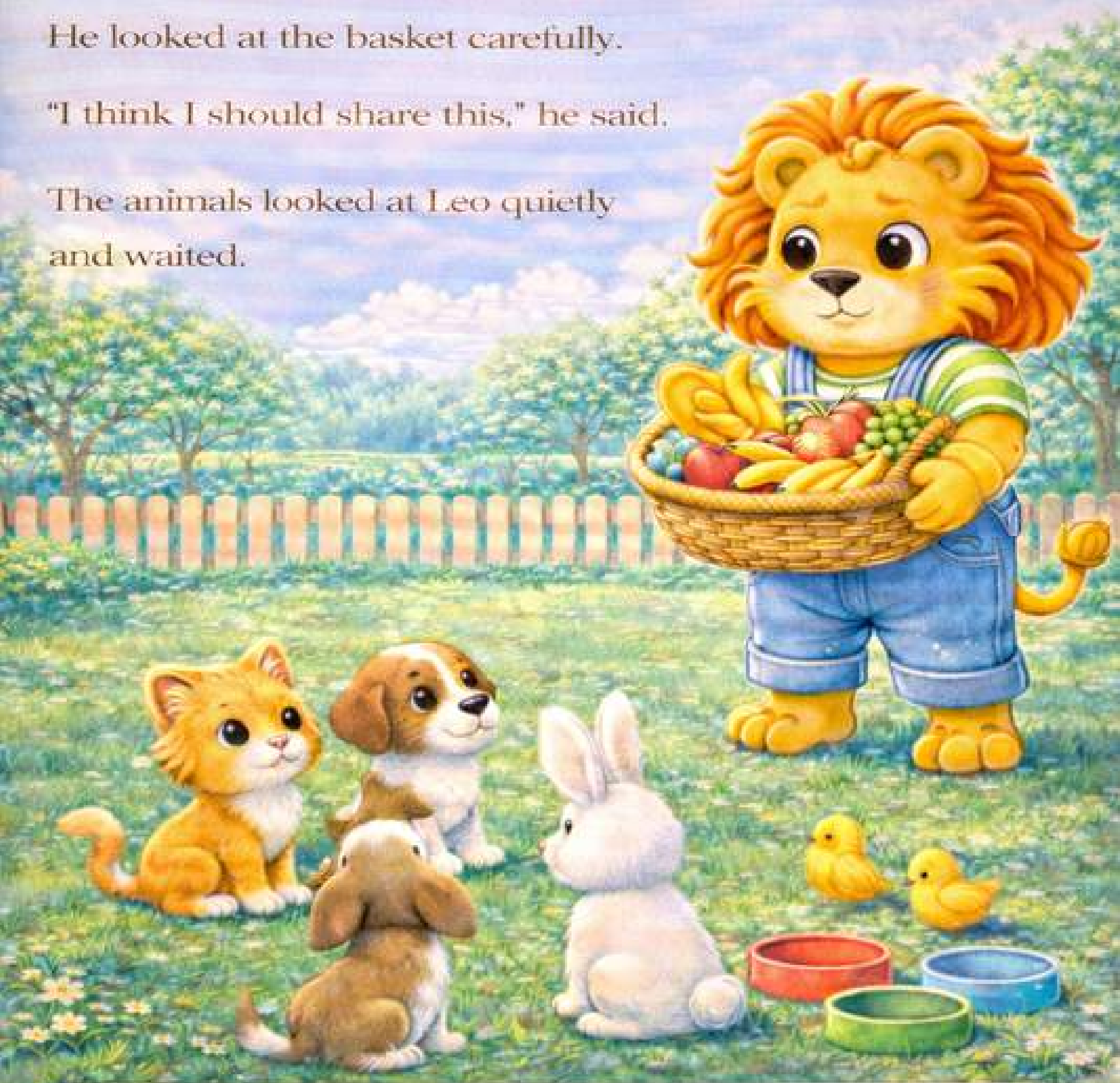
Leo walked into the yard with a basket of food.

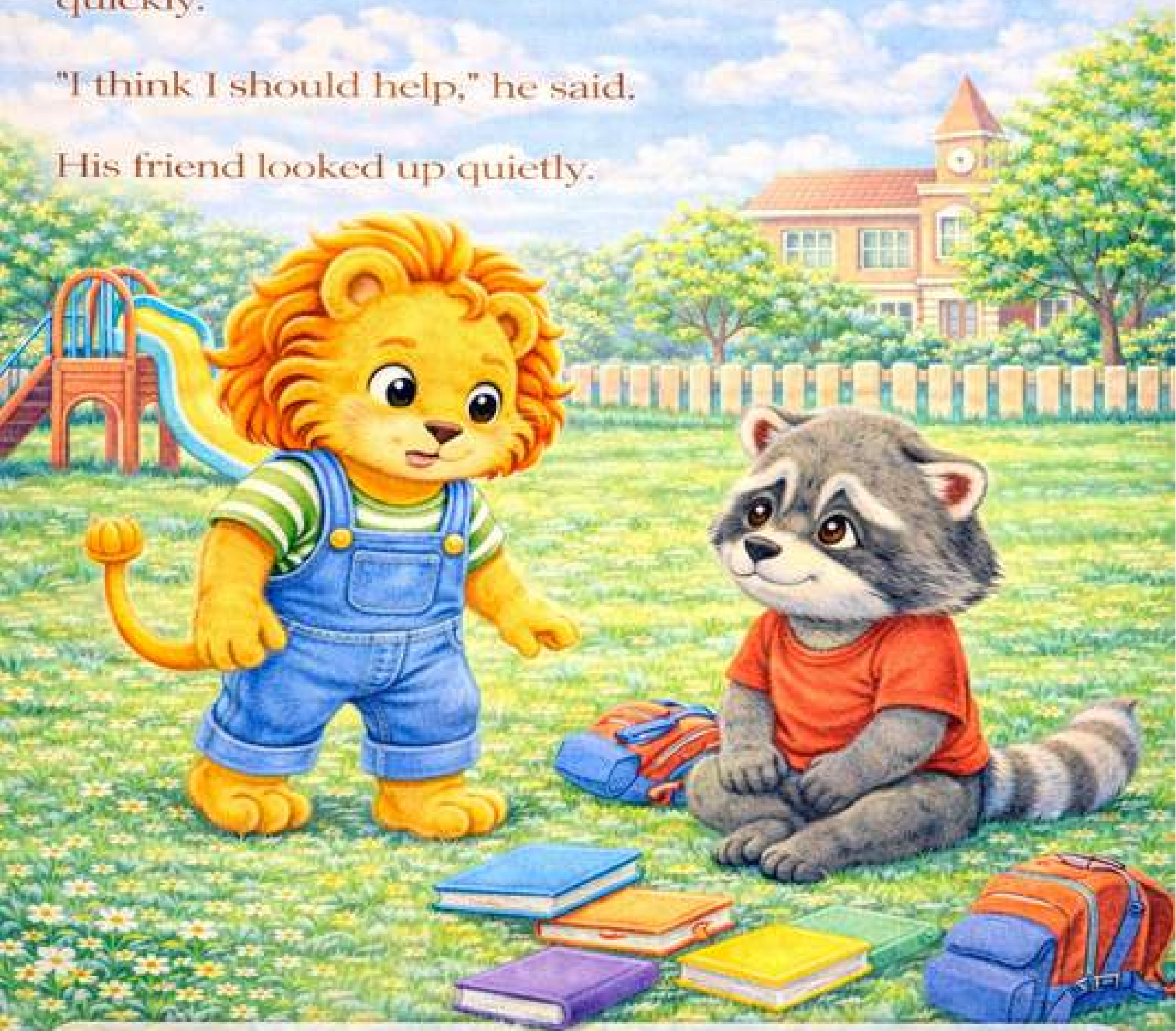
Leo walked into the playground and saw his friend sitting alone. He stopped and looked closely.

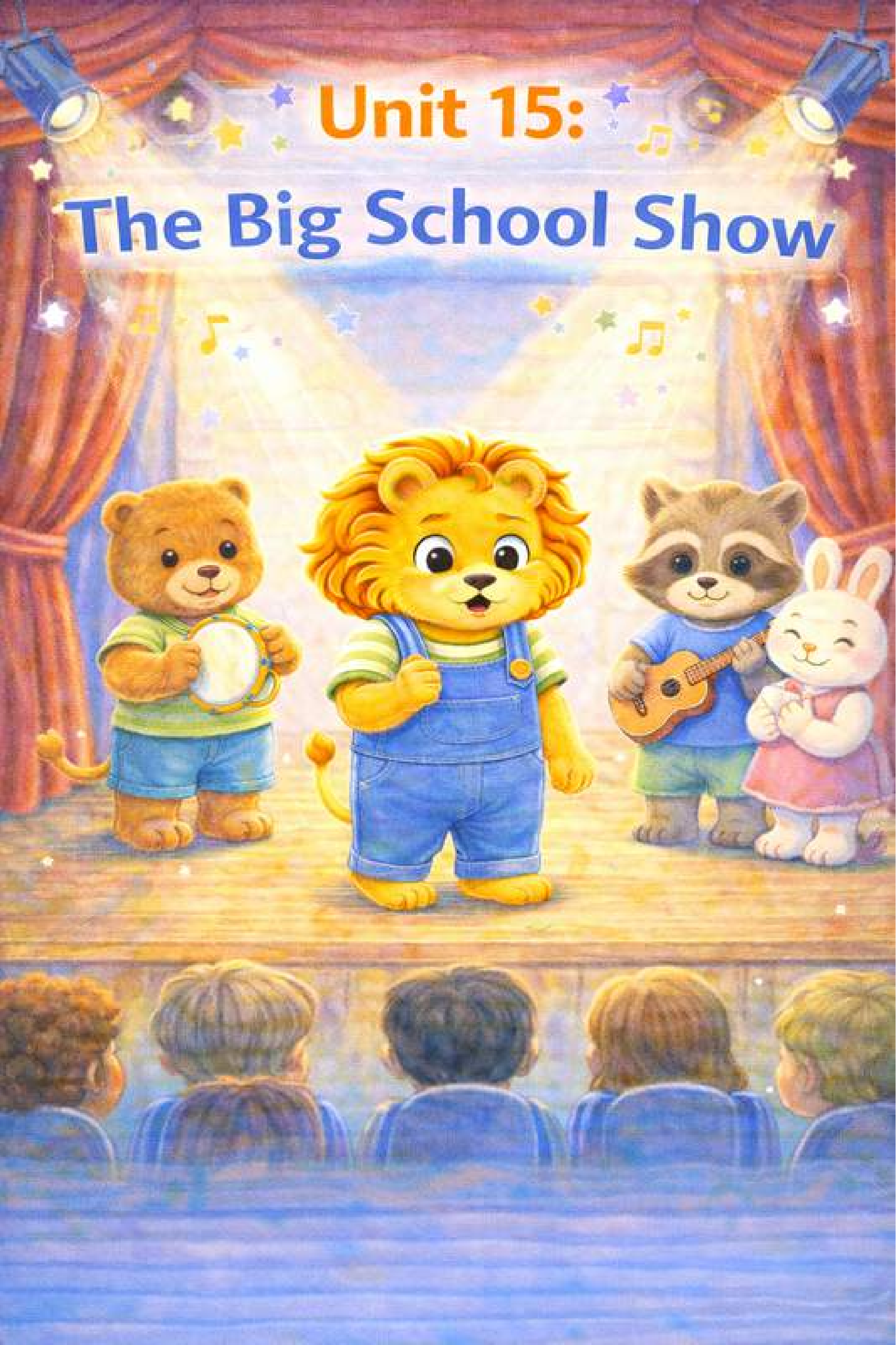
