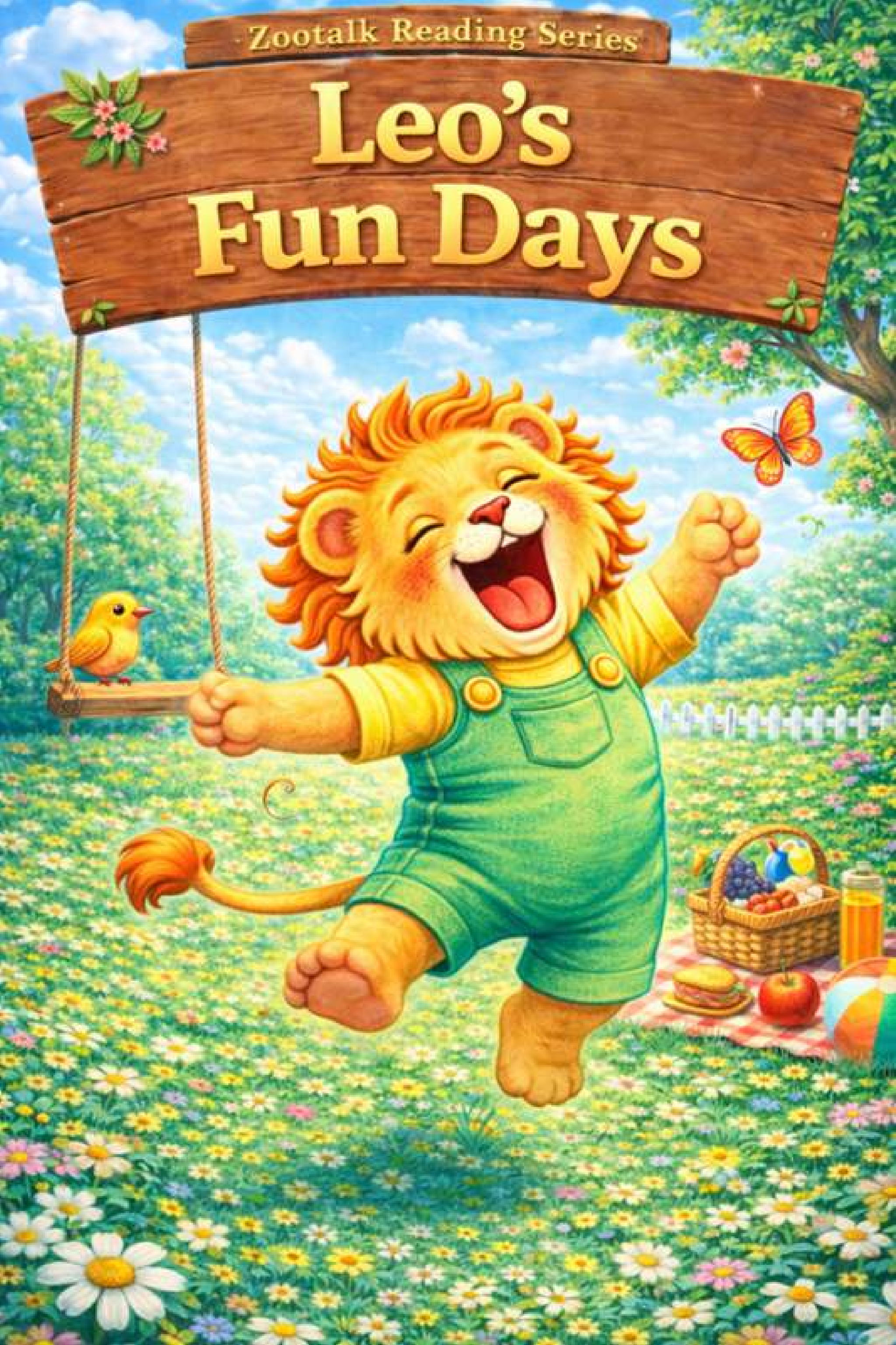


Zootalk Reading Series

- 7레벨 Kiri (과거형을 사용하며, 깊은 사고력 관련 포함)

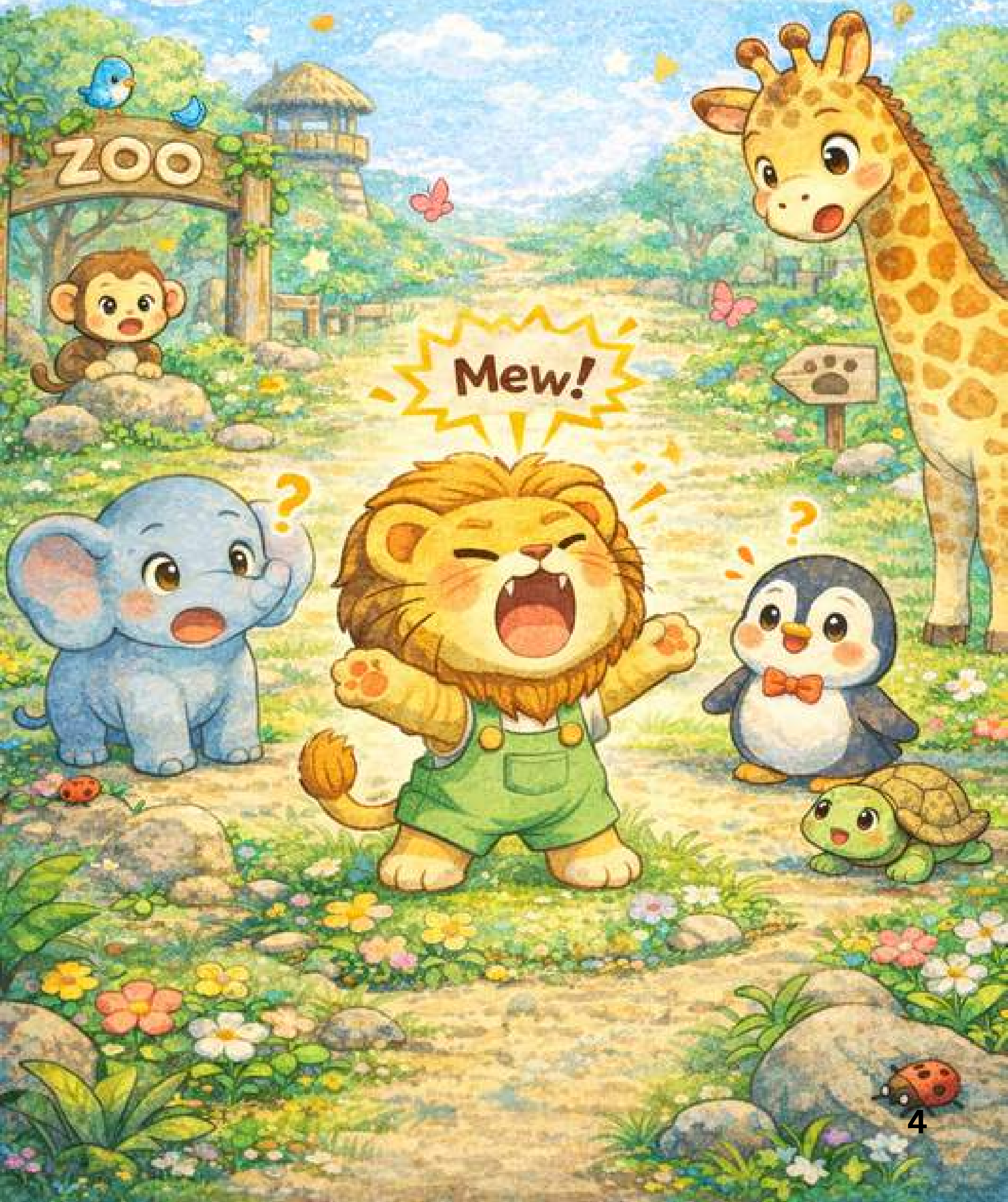

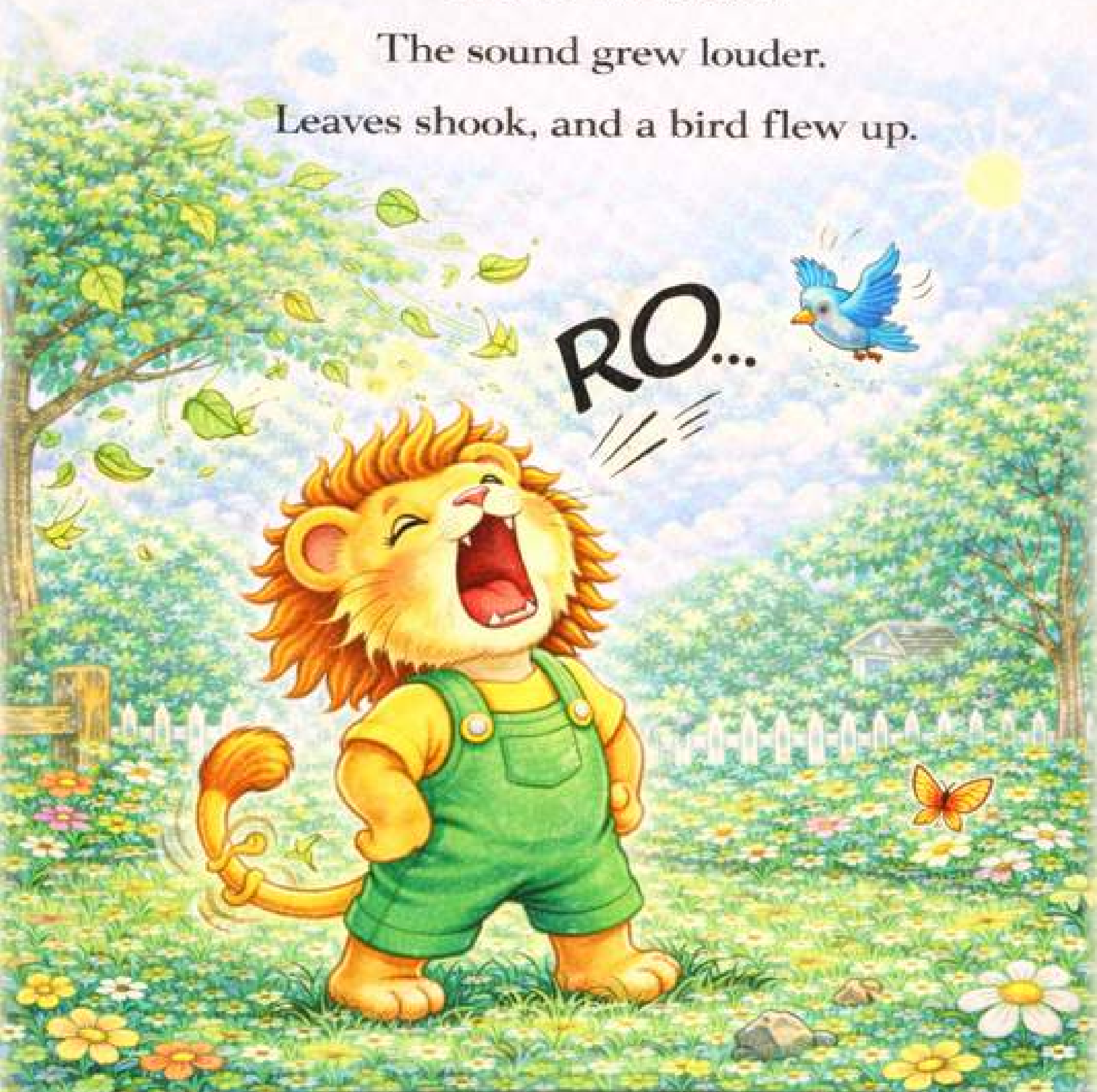
Leo took a big breath.

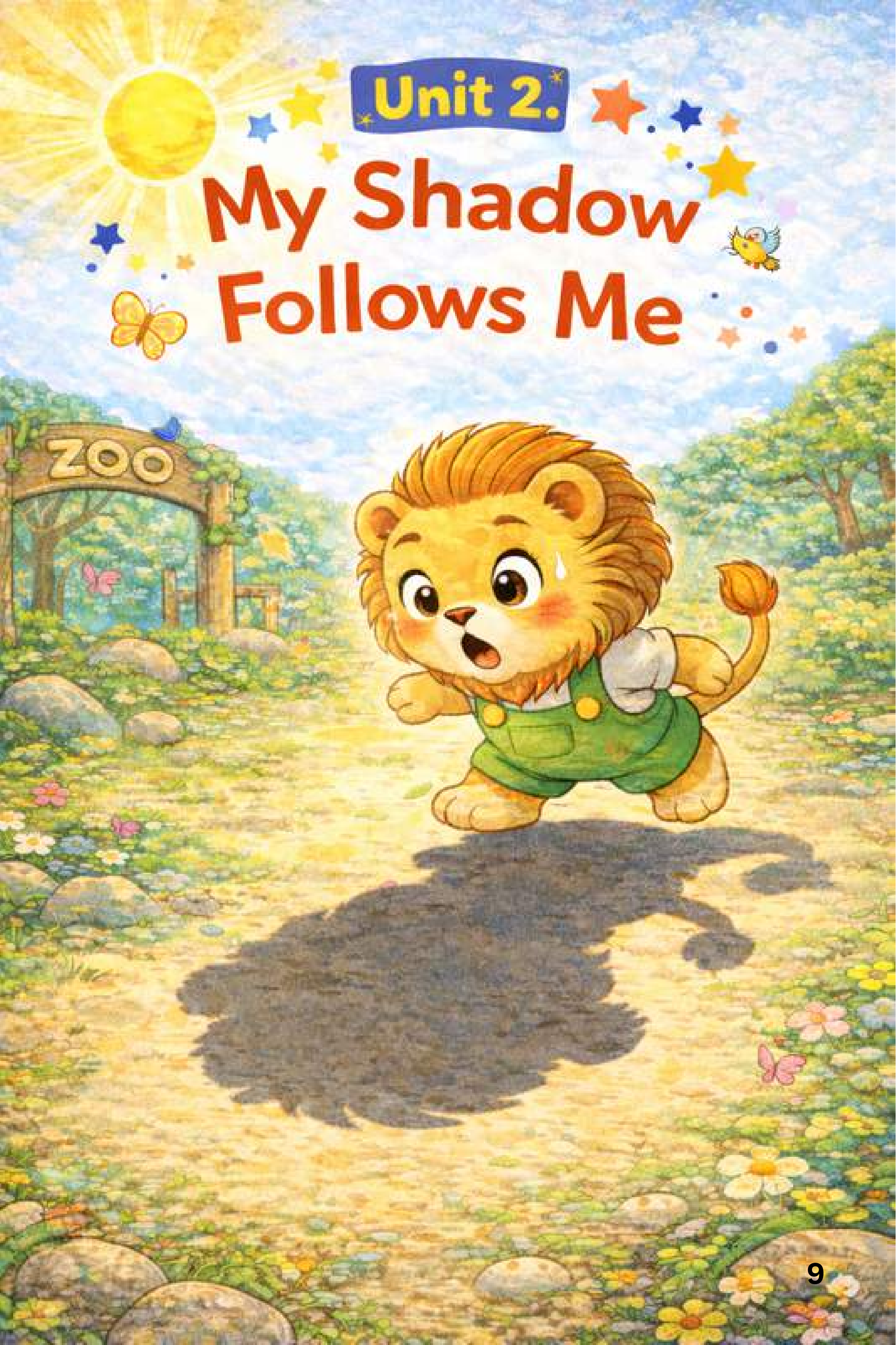

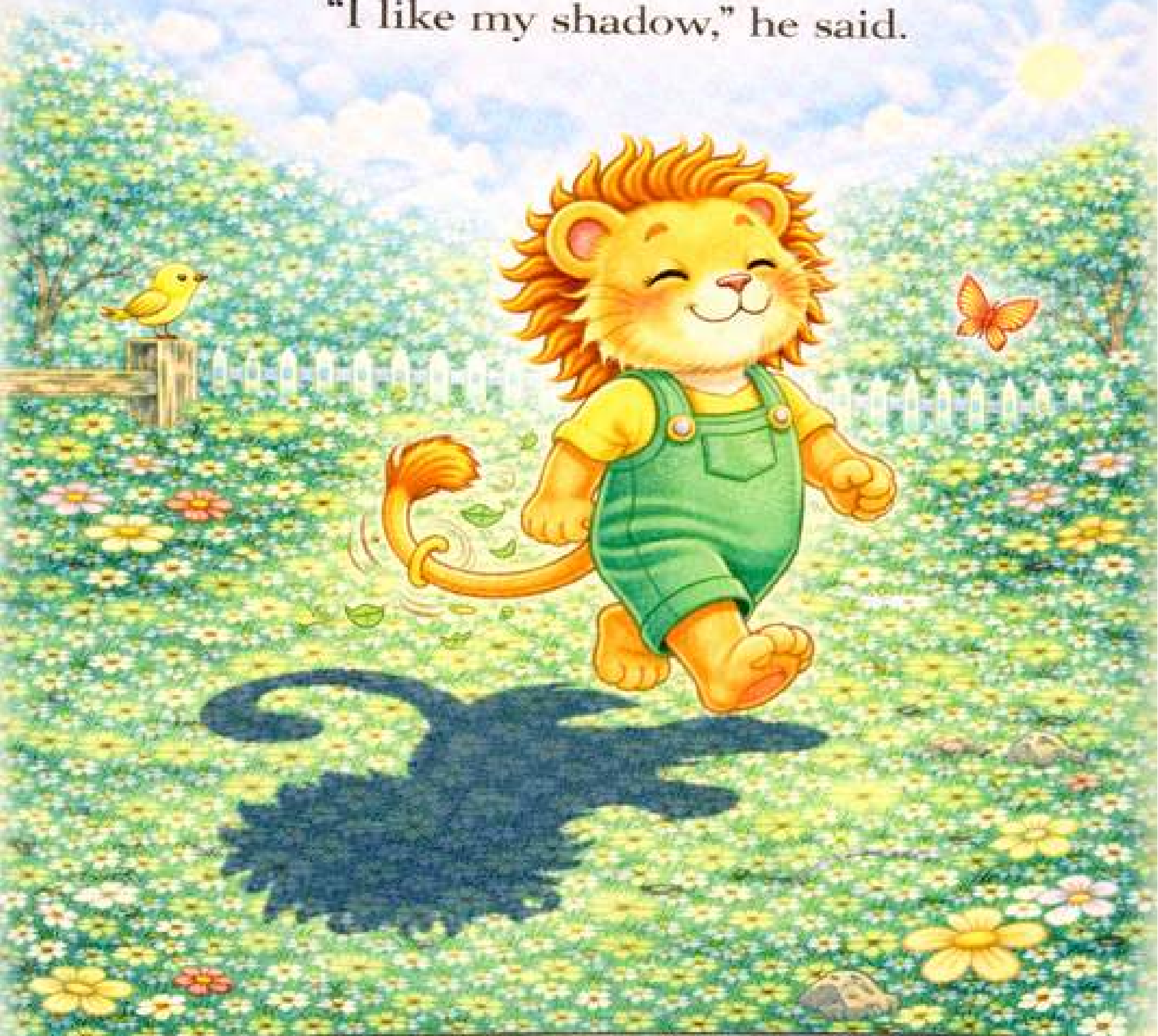

Leo walked slowly through the yard.

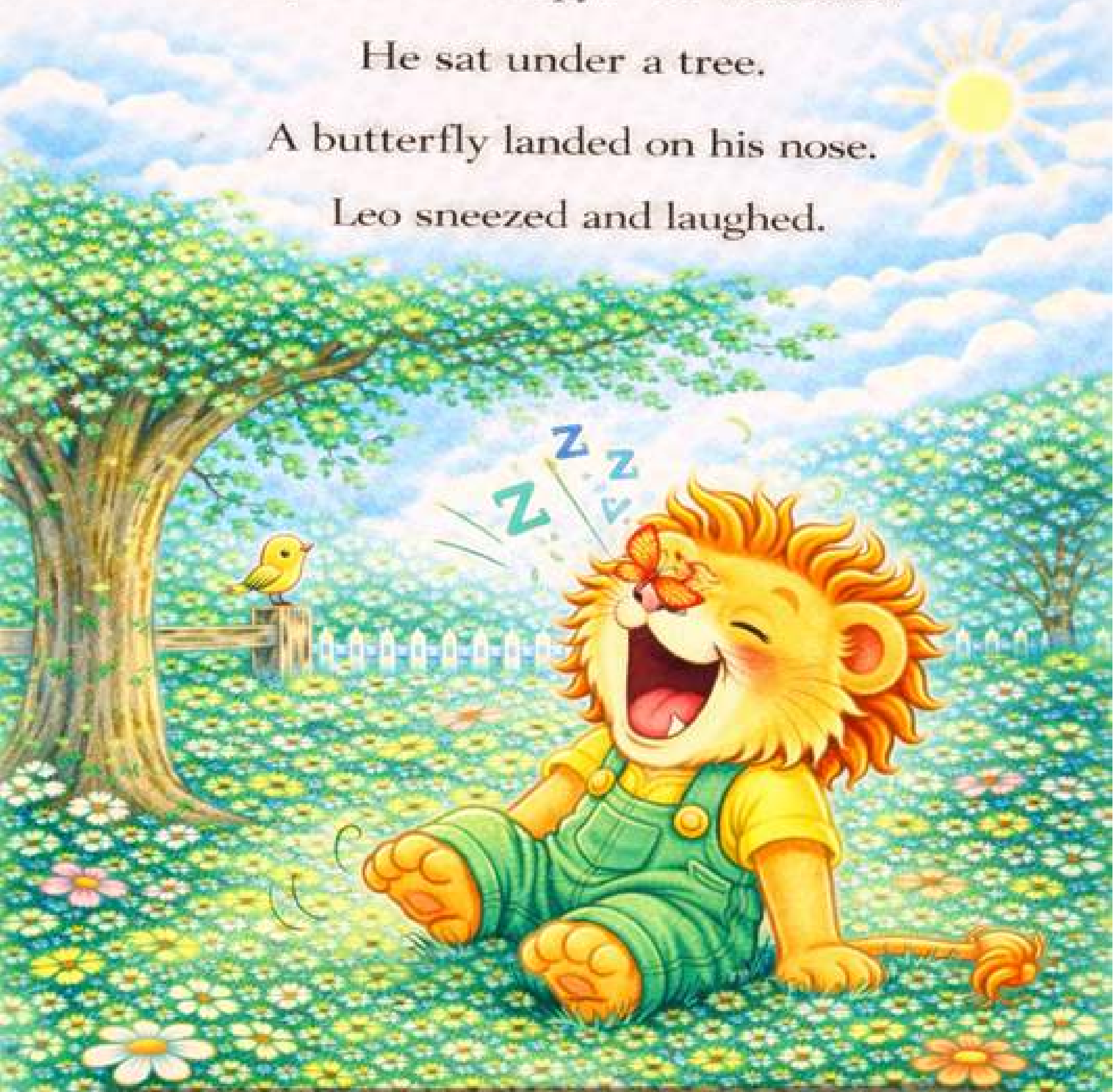
He yawned again and again.

Leo tried to play with a stick.

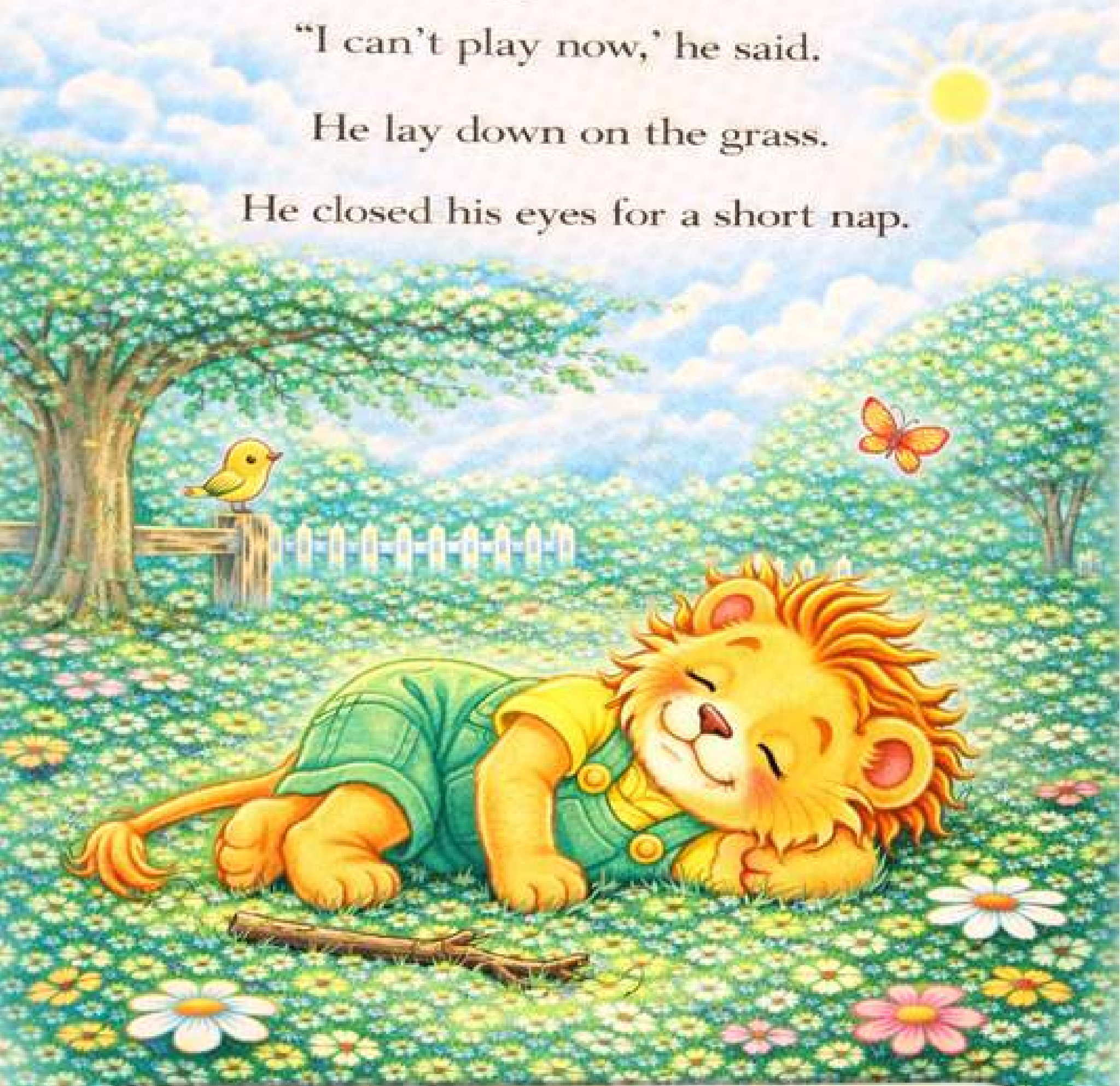
But he felt too sleepy.

He closed his eyes for a short nap.



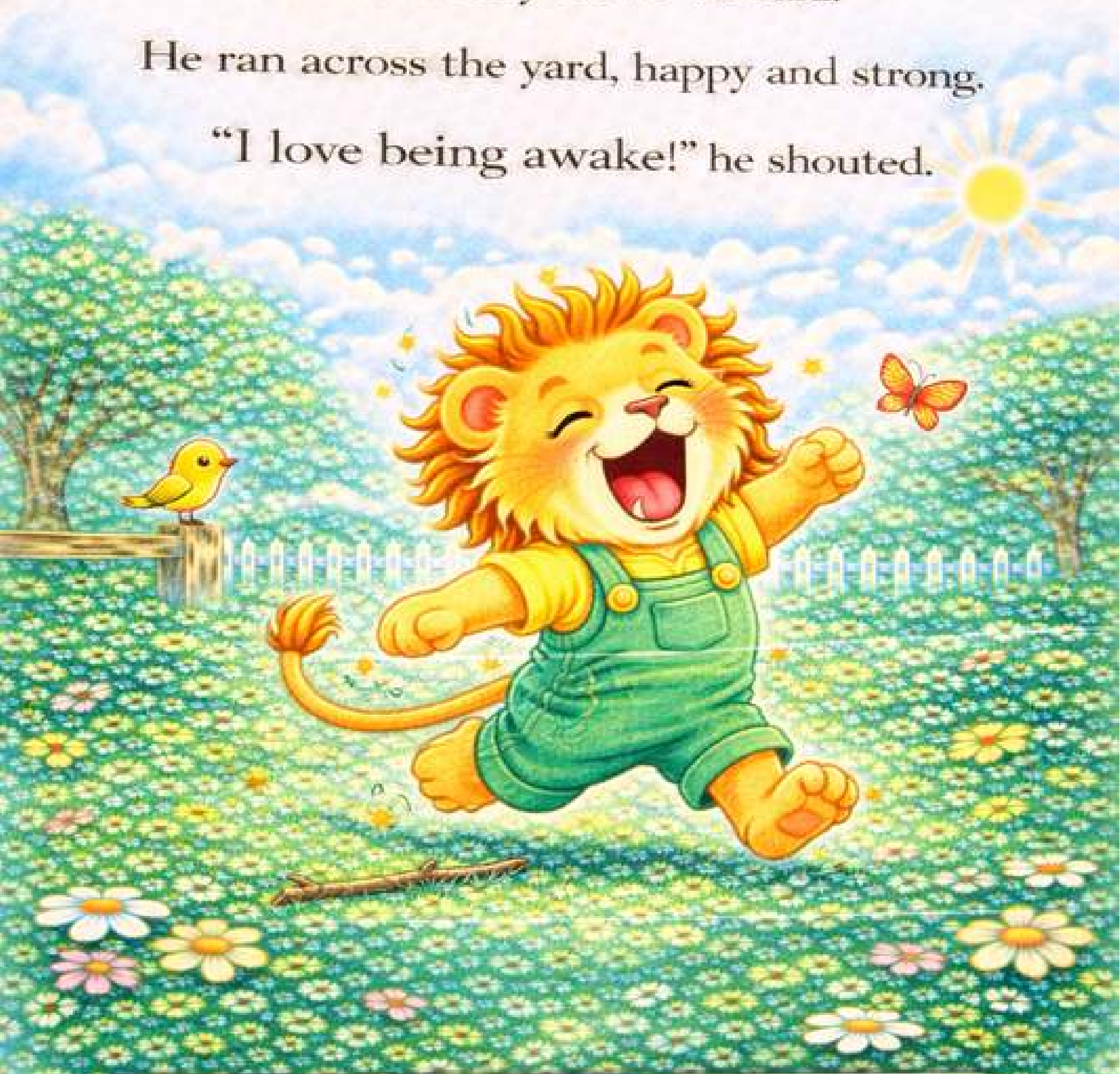

Leo felt worried.



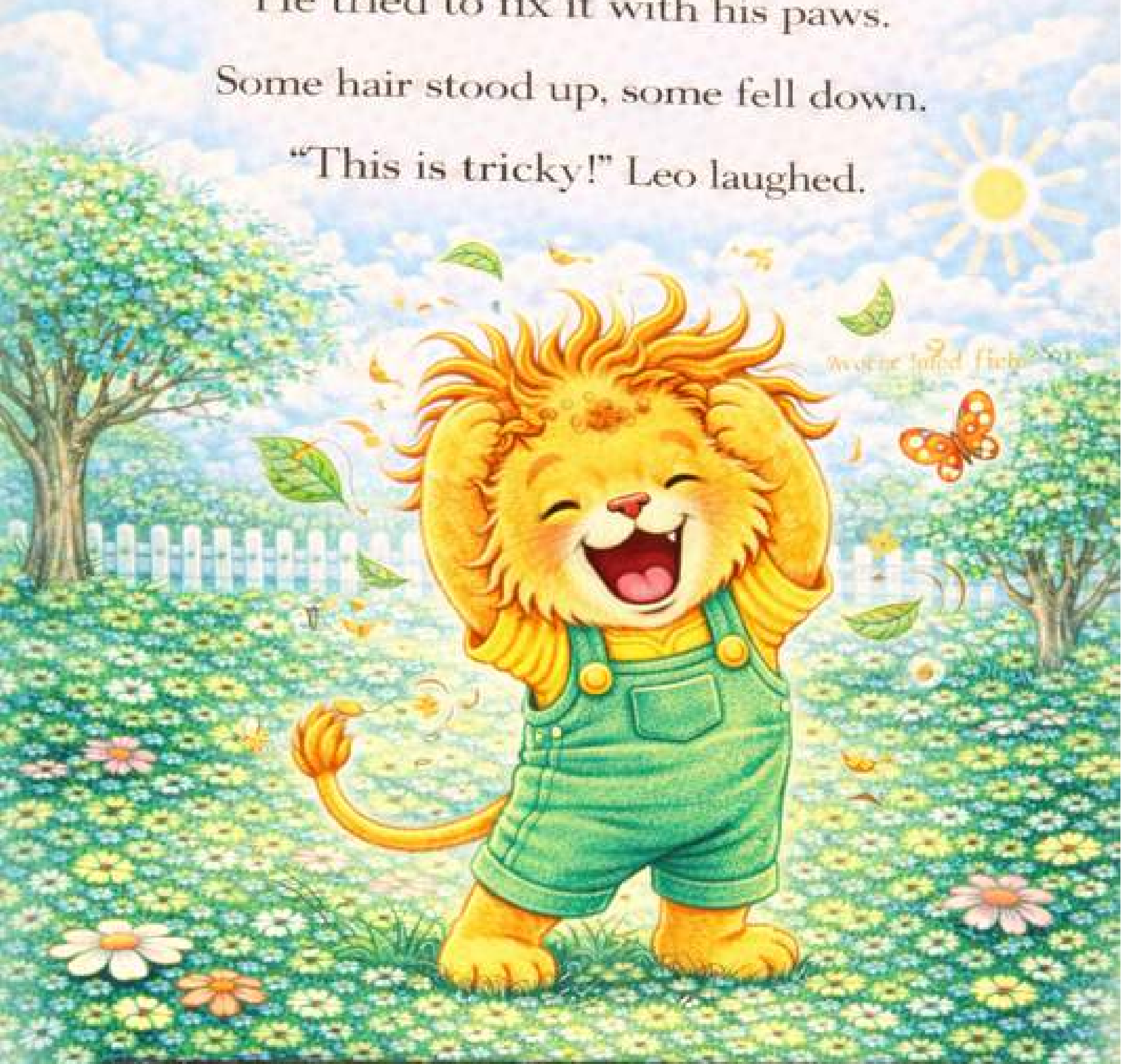

Leo saw a butterfly land on his head.

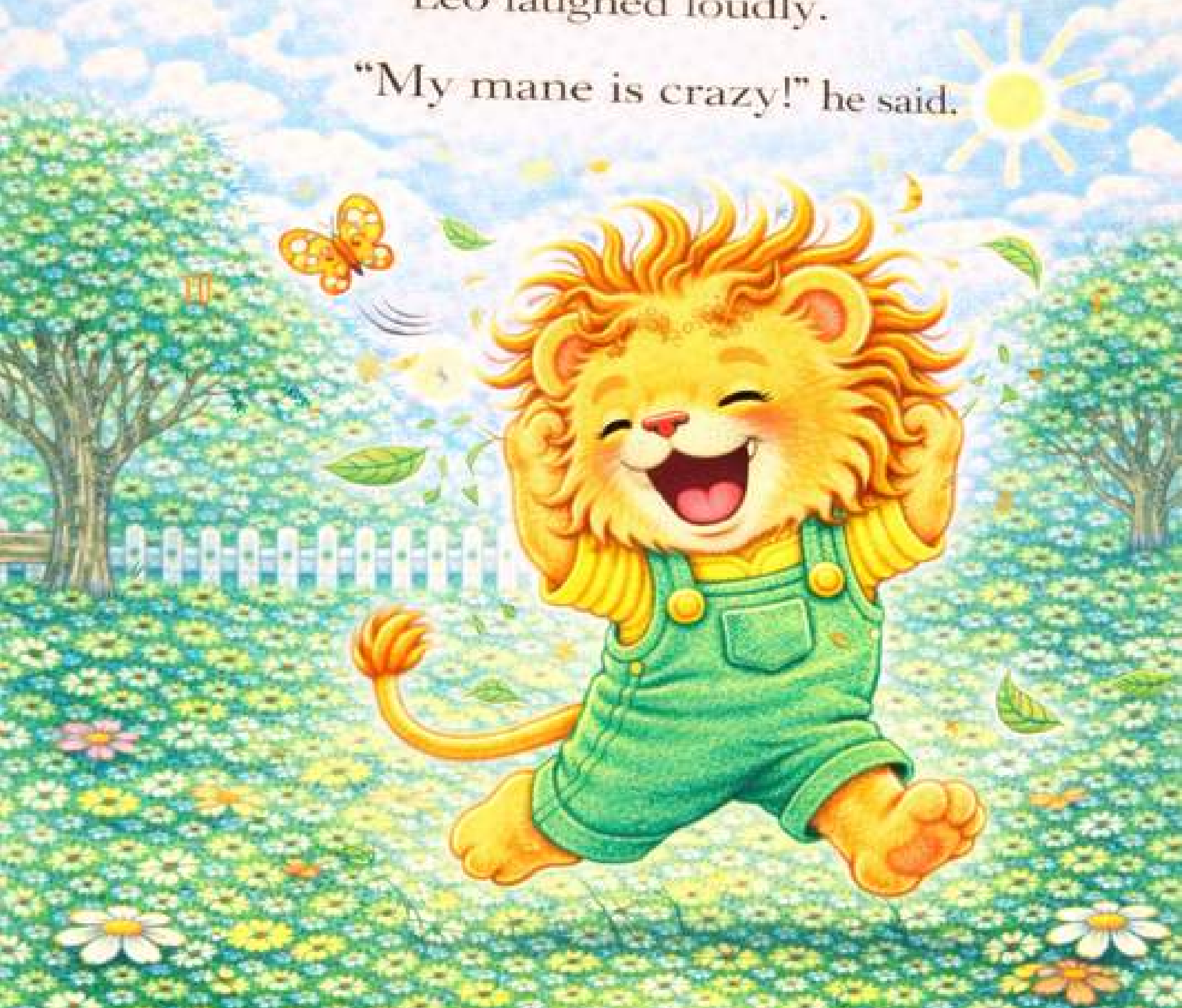
It tickled his nose.

Leo yawned again.

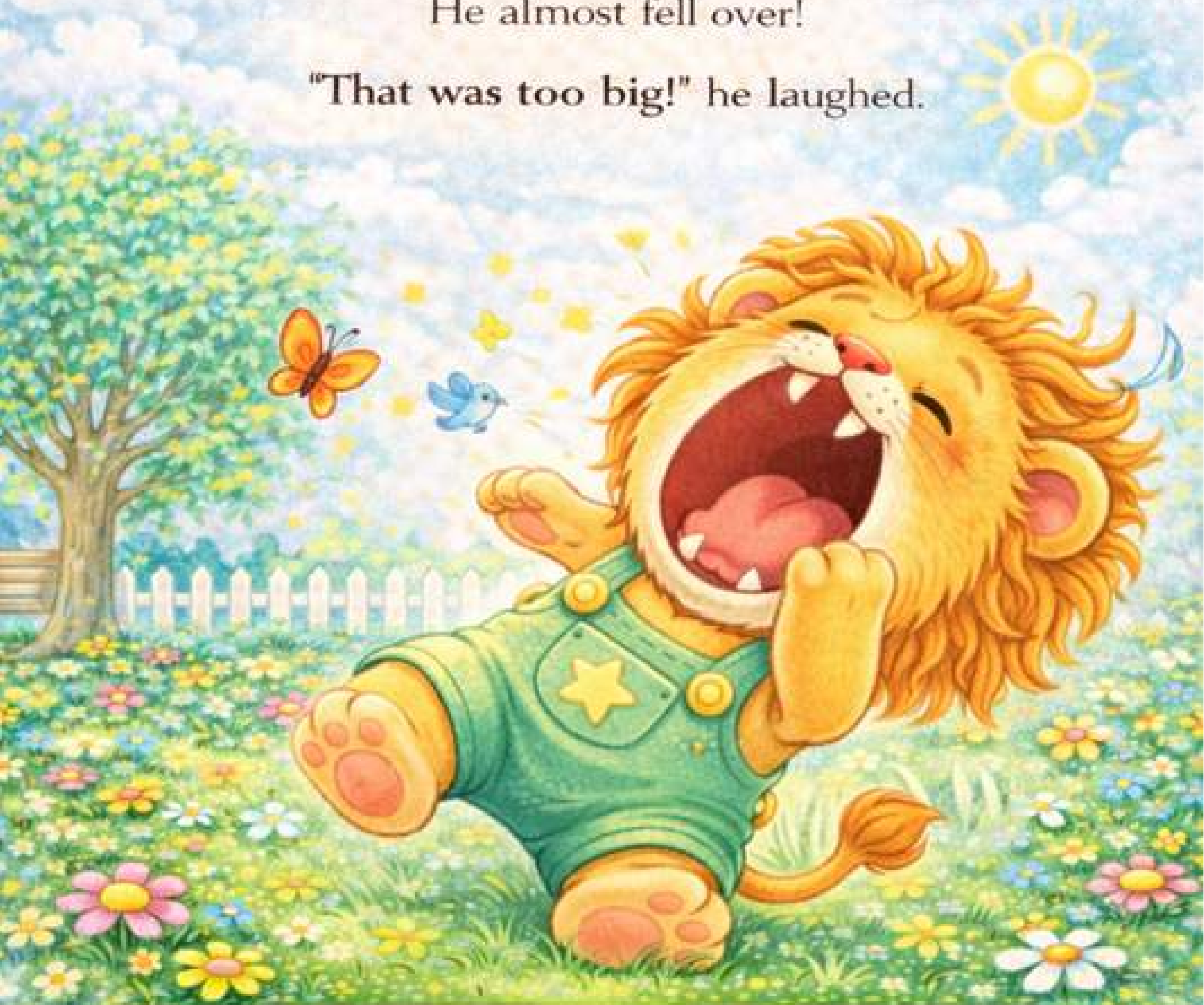
It was even bigger this time.

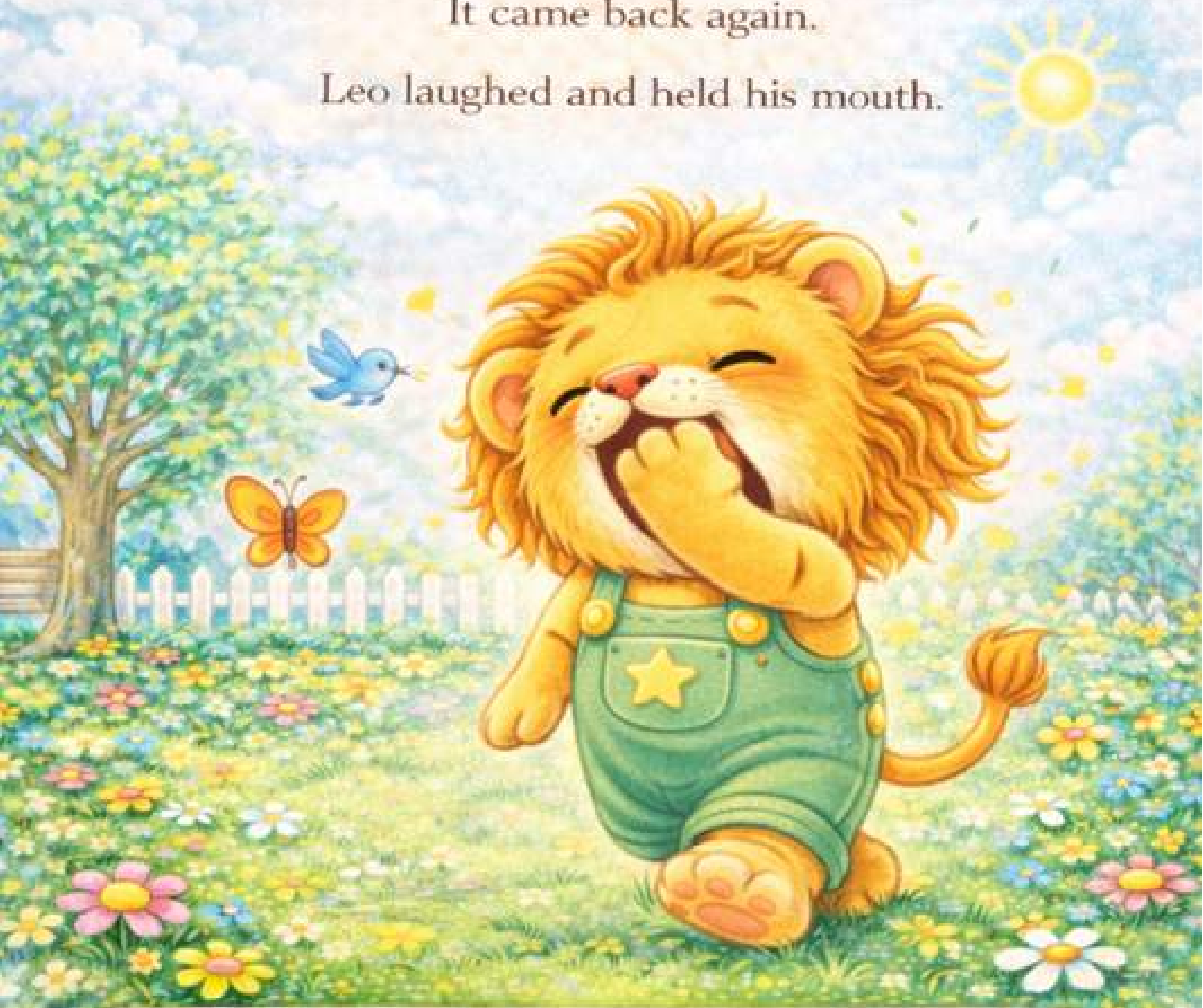

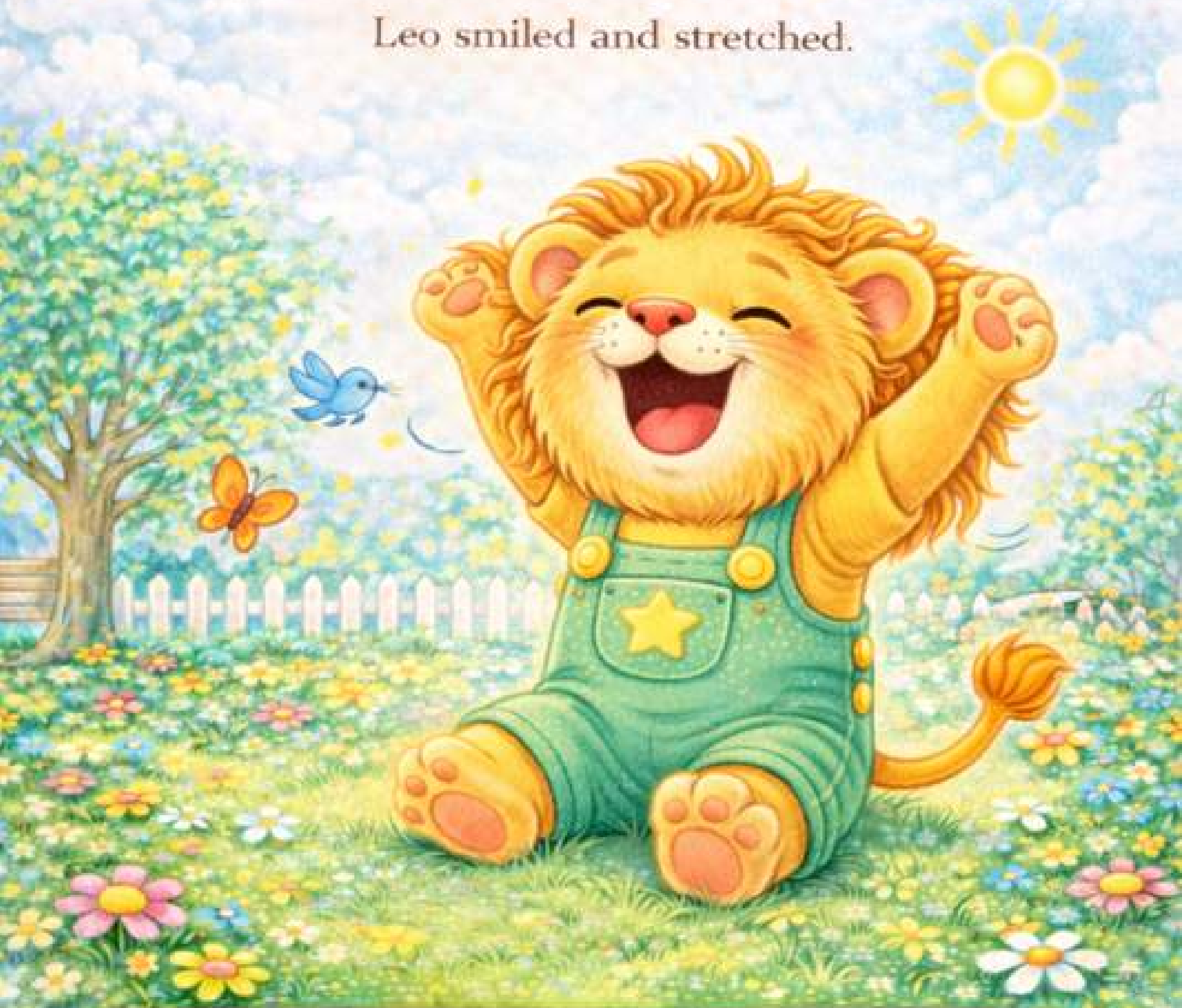
Leo sat down and rested.

Leo walked a little faster.

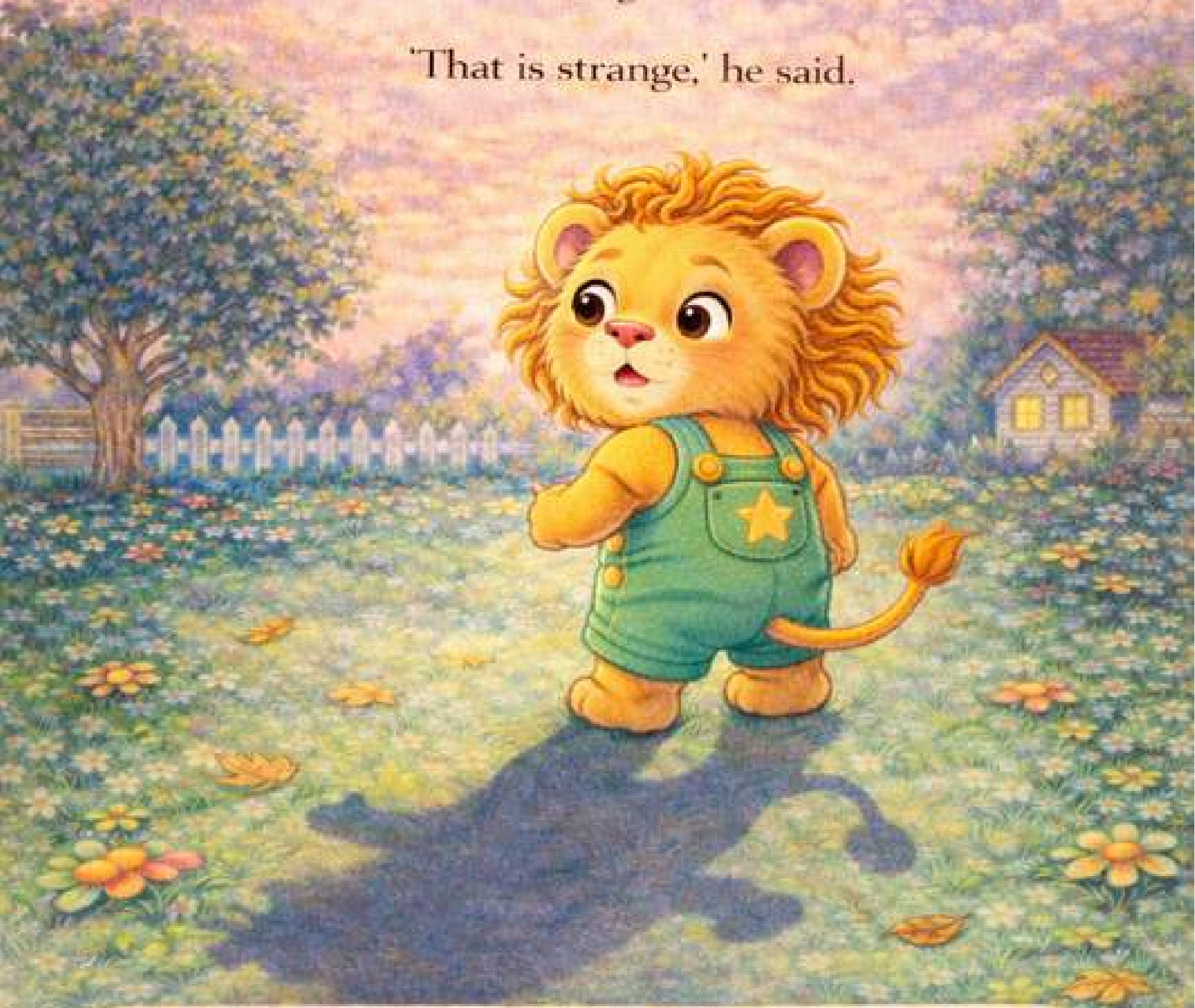
The shadow moved again.

Leo sat on the grass.

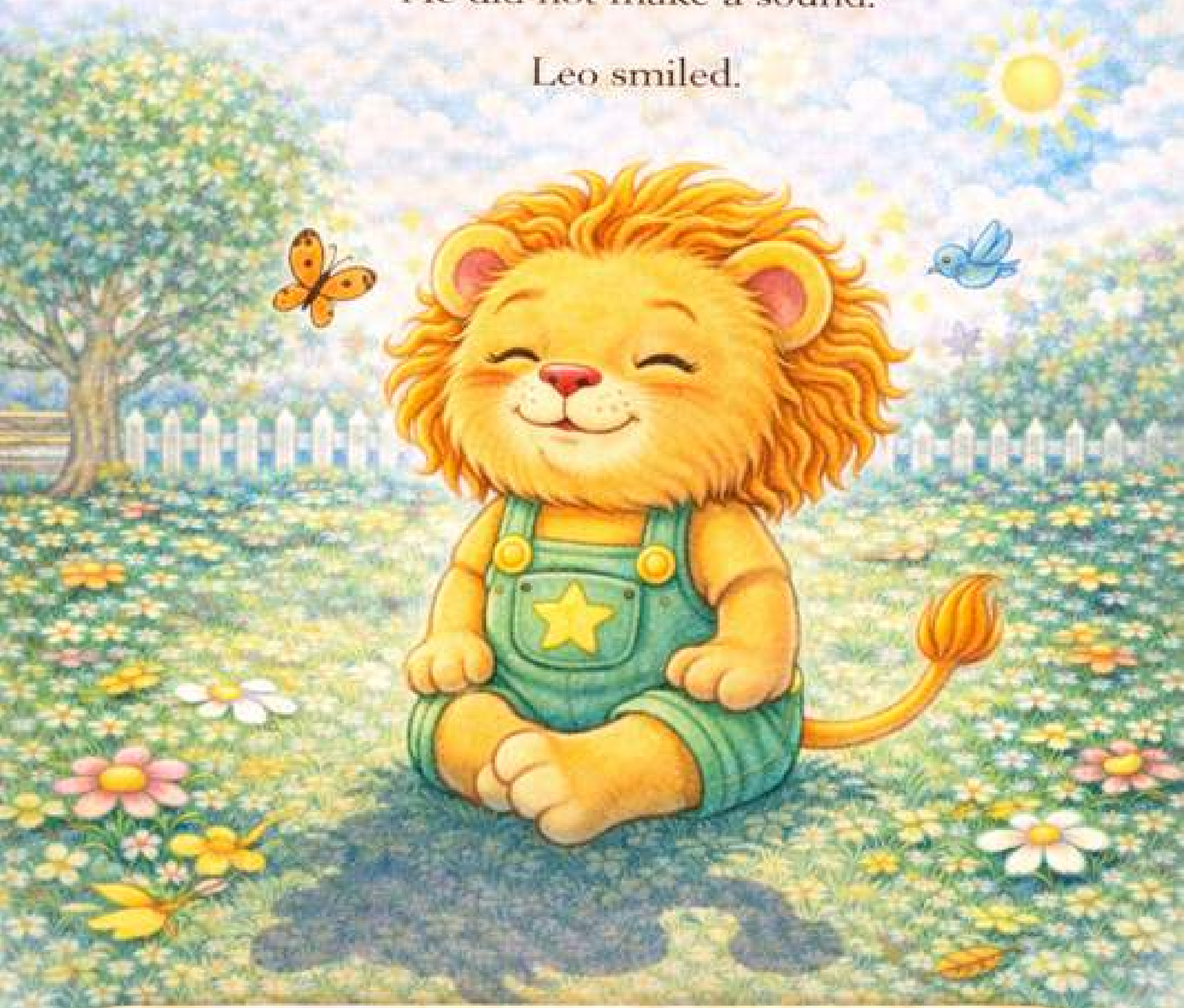
"I can be very quiet," he said.

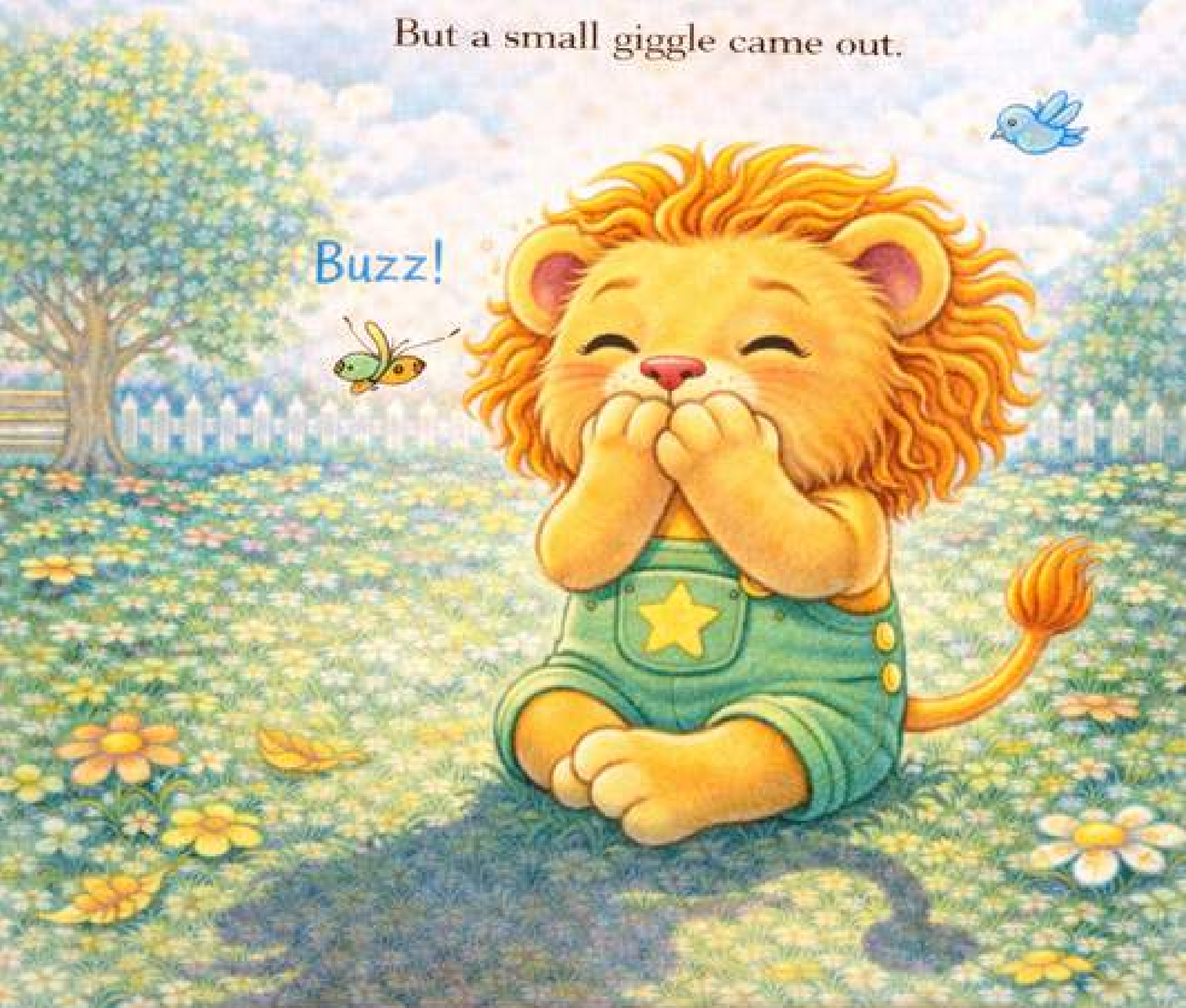

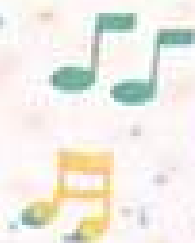

Leo sat very still.

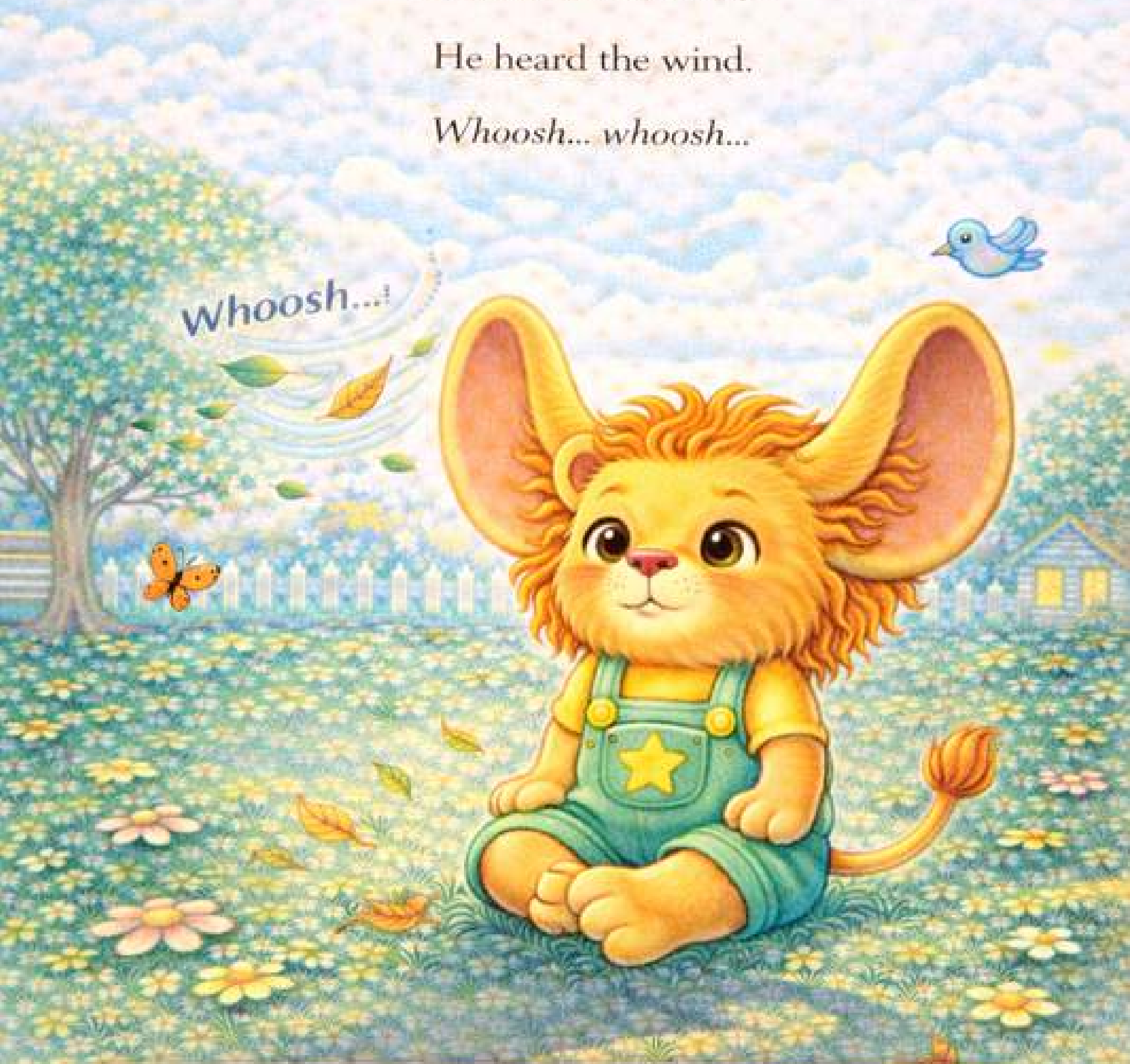
'My ears are very strong,' he said.
